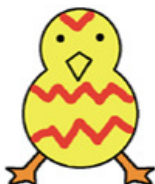

Commercial Radio News

Format Change for Stations?26 February, 2017

All local and regional commercial radio stations in the UK could easily change music format and network 24/7 if new proposals by the government are approved.

The Department of Culture Media and Sport believes that music requirements in radio formats – other than where they apply to national analogue licences – now serve very little purpose and simply act as a barrier to stations wanting to experiment with the types of music they want to play.

The Commercial Radio Deregulation Consultation, published today, wants to hear views on a package of changes to the current regulatory regime for commercial radio, which aim to bring the analogue and digital licensing arrangements into line. (currently the restrictions for FM/AM stations do not apply to DAB services.)

The proposals include replacing Ofcom's obligation to secure a range and choice of radio services with a new duty to secure the provision of news and other core information. All current format requirements which stipulate where local radio stations are broadcast from, and how many hours per day can be shared, could be ripped up, provided that the local news/etc content continues to be relevant to listeners in their coverage area and that stations continue to source local news from within the existing editorial areas defined by Ofcom.

There's also a question over whether Ofcom should continue to licence any more FM stations, instead concentrating on DAB multiplexes (www.radiotoday.co.uk)

Commercial Radio increases advertising revenue4 March, 2017

Commercial radio is celebrating a record-breaking year for advertising revenue, boosted by increased investment in the medium by online retailers.

Figures from Radiocentre show that commercial radio took £645.8 million in ad revenue in 2016, its highest ever figure. This represents a 5.4% increase on the previous year, outperforming the total 2016 advertising industry growth estimate of 4.4% from the Advertising Association/WARC.

The fourth quarter of 2016 was also the biggest on record with advertisers, growing 7.7% to £181.1 million, beating the previous record fourth quarter of £168.4 million in 2003.

Ebay increased its radio spend by 600% to £5 million in 2016, whilst ASDA and Morrisons continue to be big supporters of the medium, with spends of £9.8 and £7.1 million respectively. Sky remains the largest UK radio with spend of £19.4 million.

The motor industry, retail, entertainment and leisure, finance and government remain the biggest sectors for radio advertising but the medium was also boosted by a 90% growth in spend from online retailers, almost doubling from £6.5 million in 2015 to £12.4 million in 2016.

Siobhan Kenny, CEO of Radiocentre says: "These figures show that commercial radio is in great shape. Advertisers continue to value the reach, effectiveness and impact of radio and are making the most of its ability to reach far and wide. (www.radiotoday.co.uk)

Other News

Over fifty radio stations have now confirmed they will participate in this years' Local Radio Day event. On the day itself, 26th May, local radio stations will celebrate local radio engagement in the areas and communities they broadcast to.

Local Radio Day will be reflected by all areas of the radio industry, from the charitable, community and commercial sector through to BBC Local Radio. Paul Jenner from BBC Radio Oxford said on confirming the radio station would be participating: "We're delighted to support Local Radio Day. Every day, we're live across Oxfordshire reflecting our different communities, including historic Oxford and rural towns like Chipping Norton and Witney. On Local Radio Day itself, we'll be broadcasting from as many areas as possible in the county, hearing people's stories and getting listeners involved in their local radio station."

Dave Coull, Group Content Director at UKRD added: “I am delighted with the number of proper local radio stations that have already signalled they will be participating in Local Radio Day this year. All of which are uniquely placed to deliver content, on-air, online and on-the- street that specifically appeals to the area and communities they serve” (www.radiotoday.co.uk)

Irish News

Irish Radio Stations advertising rules questioned8 March, 2017

Dublin MEP, Brian Hayes has called on the European Commission to revise the rules concerning radio adverts.

The Fine Gael MEP wants to see the end of lengthy “terms & conditions” read at a fast pace on radio adverts. A simple message directing listeners to a website for further information makes better sense.

“The Consumer Credit Directive requires that standard information be provided in any advertising concerning credit agreements. Irish radio stations are losing revenue from this Brussels red tape requirement. The best examples are adverts for bank loans, new cars and insurance products. Radio advertising is severely disadvantaged as it does not have the visual element enjoyed by other media sources such as print, web and television.”

“When you see an advert on TV from a car manufacturer, the legal requirements for that advert are displayed in small print throughout the advert. This includes information such as the percentage of the loan interest and the required deposit. The same applies for adverts in newspapers and online.”

“Radio adverts are different. In order for radio stations to comply, they are required to read out the terms and conditions of every advert. This requirement means that a company who purchases 40 seconds of advertising can actually only advertise for 20 seconds as the remainder of the advert is filled with terms and conditions.”

“I believe the European Commission needs to revise the rules. I have written today to Vice President Timmermans, Head of Better Regulation to investigate this matter.”

“Consumers would be better advised if a simple message at the end of the advert directing them to a website was announced,” concluded MEP Hayes.

RTÉ has agreed to continue its longwave 252 until June 201913 March, 2017

After that, RTÉ hopes Radio 1 will gain approval from UK authorities to launch via a chain of small broadcast networks which cover main urban centres. Currently, a broadcaster has to be based in the UK to obtain an Ofcom licence.

RTÉ says using the DAB+ platform will be considerably less (approx. one fifth) than the present quarter of a million per annum that RTÉ expends in running costs for 252.

Minister of State for the Diaspora, Joe McHugh T.D., has welcomed the recommendations: “I am delighted that there is now a way forward that takes into account as much as possible the views of older members of the Irish community in Britain. I have committed to making a contribution to this via the Government of Ireland Emigrant Support Programme. The research we funded on this issue has made clear that RTÉ Radio is a fantastic resource for Irish people in Britain. I’d like also to acknowledge the leadership the Irish community in Britain has shown on this.”

RTÉ plan to launch a service on DAB+ digital radio modelled from RTÉ Radio 1 and to work with stakeholders to maintain contact with the Irish community in Britain. Details of this service are still being worked out but it is likely to include a limited amount of new targeted programming commissioned for audiences in Britain. As a terrestrial radio service this is subject to regulatory approval in the UK.

The UK Government is currently in consultation about deregulating the radio industry, including the option to have a foreign company hold a radio licence. (www.irishpost.co.uk)
