Utan att veta vilken station som gör det kände man bl a till att det förekommer på just 1390 och 1530. JE

Hej alla, förmedlar Per-Ole Stenmans hälsningar till läsekretsen och de gamla DX kompisarna. En ny NA fixades för 47 säsongen i rad i Purmo QTH:et, en anmärkningsvärd prestation!

POS skriver:

”Säsong 47 gav även en ny NA för mig. En kort intensiv ök-topp 11.11. gav AM 1700 WRCR. Hördes i 20 minuter 06.20-06.40 UTC i mitt Purmo QTH.

For ut till stugan och knäppte på radion 06.05 cirkus så behövde inte vänta länge på leverans. Target-DX kunde man väl säga, låt vara att WRCR är ett lätt byte då konditionerna ligger mot ÖK, hur som helst ohörd för mig sedan tidigare. Har nu bytt ut relädosan från ifjol, och lyckats kasta om NNW och ÖK antennen. Det märkte jag inte 24.9 då jag kopplade in antennerna, då gick alla indikatorstationer, typ Island och 153-Norge med styrkorna i topp. Skottland-810 hördes inte, på den kommer tydligast fram vilken av antennerna är i bruk. Då jänkarna kommer in är det genast stor skillnad på dessa två antenner, och LA har jag svårt att överhuvudtaget få in. Har även kopplat in en 300 meter ojordad antenn rakt i söder, även om den drar in starka européer, gick det även NA på denna. Lämnar tillsvidare utrustningen uppkopplad och ser hur långt jag kommer med denna stump. 680 gick nämligen bäst på denna backloop 11.11 på eftermiddagen vid 1400 UTC tiden. Antennarbetet i höstas gick alldeles enligt ritningarna, ÖK antennen hade tyngts ner av snö och de första 200 metrarna behövdes få i skick, ett träd som lutade över antennen togs bort. NNW antennen fick jag i fjol höstas knipa av efter att en storm fällt ett träd över den, så den skarvades ihop igen. Skogsmaskinens fortsatta framfart över nedgrävd koaxialkabel hade inte gjort någon skada. Kabelsidan har jag varit speciellt nöjd med nu, inga problem överhuvudtaget, men så är alla skarvar noggrant hoplödda och isolerade. Framför allt hade det nog funnits förutsättningar för id på en hel del intressanta brassar runt 01 UTC om det inte pratats fotboll överallt.

Mot morgonen blev det snabbt allt sämre signaler och framför allt på övre delen av mellanvågen var det ganska tomt redan 04.30. Vid soluppgången i stället några enstaka östkust-NA.

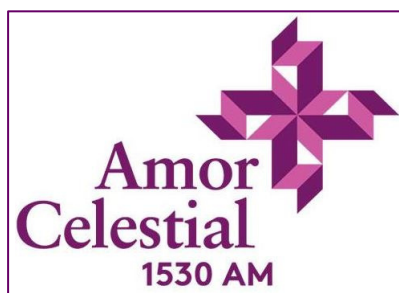

Algeria

891 The new 600 kW transmitter delivered by Transradio in Berlin and Ampegon in Switzerland seems to have some problems. It has been testing daily using a 1 kHz tone. The transmitter and the antenna have been partly renewed and are located in the town of Ouled Fayet, just under 20 km to the west of Algiers. The town is a telecom centre and is growing rapidly. All satellite reception for Algiers and surrounding areas is concentrated to Ouled Fayet. – When this transmitter is off it is possible to hear Ethiopia, Iran and China in the late afternoon. (Bengt Ericson, ARC 20.11.2016)

Ouled Fayet was the original high power site on 980 kHz (now 981), which has a two tower array screening the signal towards co-channel Gothenburg. The Tesla made SW site Bouchaoui is located just across the street from Ouled Fayet. (ed)

Albania

As of January 2017 Trans World Radio will stop its broadcasts on the medium wave frequency 1395 kHz from Albania. The discontinuation of broadcasts from Albania could mean good news for the low power AM transmitters in the Netherlands that broadcast on 1395 kHz.

Trans World Radio will use other medium wave stations in Europe to achieve its targets. For example, the radio programme is broadcast on a medium wave transmitter of Radio Monte Carlo 1467 kHz and a medium wave frequency from Georgia 1548 kHz. The transmitter in Albania is in a poor condition and there is no money to renovate it. Trans World Radio was the only radio channel still using the transmitter near Tirana. The transmissions, which take place in the evening hours, use high power and can also be received in the Netherlands.

The Netherlands is also currently using 1395 kHz for low-power transmissions up to 100 watts. Under the current broadcasting licences, the Dutch stations are not allowed to broadcast between sunset and sunrise on this frequency.

With the disappearance of broadcasts from Albania it should be possible for radio stations that broadcast on 1395 kHz in the Netherlands to broadcast 24 hours a day via this frequency. The Radiocommunications Agency will have to give formal consent, however.

Current broadcasters on 1395 kHz include Seabreeze Radio AM (Friesland) and Q-AM (Gelderland) via this frequency. In addition, there are various authorizations issued by the Radiocommunications Agency for stations that have not yet started broadcasting.

Azerbaijan

This autumn I haven't been able to hear Azerbaijan on either of their usual frequencies: 801 or 891 kHz. Both have been some tens of a Hz above nominal and are rather regular catches here in Finland. Also the very weak Voice of Azerbaijan transmitter on 1296 kHz has been missing these months. I'd be glad to be proven wrong, but looks like another country may be gone from medium wave. (Mauno Ritola, ARC)

882 COPE, Tenerife. Spanish comments, program "La Tarde con Expósito", at 1550 local commercial advertisements.

Finland

729 Pispalan Radio is now 100 W 24/7 permanent licence. Reception in Sahalahti 40 km east of Tampere is S3, better than FM 99,5. Editor Jari Niemelä suddenly passed away in August 2016. Thus new address: Pispalan Radio, c/o Pasi Komsa, Alasentie 10, FI-39200 Kyröskoski, Finland.

Germany

1107 AFN The Eagle, Vilseck, finally closed down the 10 kW transmitter in late October. (Bengt.Ericson, ARC 6.11.2016)

India

On 26 October at 1055 UTC, the Deputy Director General of All India Radio North East inaugurated the new DRM MW 200 kW transmitter of AIR Siliguri (Bengal). In his speech broadcast until 1115 UTC, he announced that the power of the analogue transmission on 711 kHz is 194 kW while the DRM-power on 720 kHz is 6 kW. The primary channel is also streamed at the website <http://www.airsiliguri.in/live.html> which was inaugurated about one year ago.

All India Radio Siliguri was commissioned on 7 July 1963 as a 20 kW auxiliary station of All India Radio Kolkata to provide medium wave coverage to the people of North Bengal. On 8 August 1982, the station was upgraded to the status of a full-fledged station of its own right. The high power transmitter (200 kW) now replaced was commissioned in 1987. (Alok Dasgupta 26.10.2016 DX India via Dr. Hansjoerg Biener, Ydun's Medium Wave Info 27.10.2016)

Iran

A couple of Iran items from my contact: R. Fars 603 kHz antenna was damaged in an airplane crash. Now it has been fixed, but they decided to use 666 kHz instead, from which Shushtar has moved to 558 kHz, as has Azarshahr 531 kHz. 990 kHz has transmitted R. Fars in the meantime, but should return back to R. Iran network in the near future. (Mauno Ritola, ARC)

The Netherlands

747 Radio Seagull is now also on this fq, using a 100 W licence on the radioship Jenny Bayton, moored in the harbour of Harlingen. The management describes it as an extended test. Here at my location, near Groningen, I do hear a mix of two signals now. Radio Seagull and Radio TPot, a station near Assen. There is a problem in zero-beat at one of the stations. So it is not clear whether this would diminish or increase its signal toward North America, where it has occasionally been DXed, around sign-on *0258 UT (Glenn Hauser, DXLD 4.11.2016)

Slovenia

549 Radio Koper and 1170 Radio Capodistria have been off the air for an extended period for repairs to the transmitters and antenna. Late in the afternoon on 12th November tests were conducted on 1170 kHz. On the next day there were a few breaks, but after that they have been in full operation. 1170 is heard very well, while 549 has problems with co-channel Ukraine. (Bengt Ericson, ARC 20.11.2016)

United Kingdom

1386 R J-Com, Leeds - the AM frequency closed on 31 October 2016 according to BDXC-UK.

“Yes, unfortunately, we have thrown in the towel with AM because of the cost vs. reach. As a not-for-profit community station, we recently lost one of our main sponsors, and because we are such a compact team (i.e. there are so few of us volunteers) we have been unable to organise sufficient fund-raising events to produce the required capital to continue on AM. We remain on the internet at www.radiojcom.com and will soon have a smartphone app available. And we are also still available through the Tune-In application.” (Official station source via Steve Whitt 7.11.2016)

BBC increases audience around the world (this is not mainly concerned with MW –ed)

The BBC reaches a record weekly audience of 348 million people worldwide, a 13 per cent increase on last year, according to new figures released today.

For the second year running, radio comes in second with 147m listeners, compared with television on 162m. Digital has 80m. In total, 152m are accessing BBC news in English; 201m in another language. The audience for non-English language TV (91m) is nearly as big as the audience for non-English language radio (94m).

The figures – the BBC Global Audience Measure – represent the combined measured reach of international content, both news and entertainment, for the year 2015/16.

They show that the BBC’s weekly global news audience has increased by 38m people, or 13 per cent, to a total of 320 million.

BBC World Service English radio has again shown a significant audience upturn, with an audience of 66m. The BBC World Service has seen its audience increase to 246m, from 210m last year. This growth is largely driven by new TV news bulletins in languages other than English.

BBC Global News Ltd, which comprises BBC World News and bbc.com, has seen its audience grow to 108m.

Francesca Unsworth, Director of BBC World Service Group, says: “These are fantastic results which show the BBC going from strength to strength around the world and demonstrate the global appetite for accurate, impartial news.

“We’re about to begin the biggest expansion of the World Service since the 1940s, thanks to the additional funding agreed by the UK Government last year.

“This will ensure we reach more people than ever, especially in countries where media freedom is under threat.”

Tim Davie, Director of Global and CEO of BBC Worldwide, comments: “BBC Worldwide continues to fuel international audiences’ appetite for premium content, and in the second year of the Global Audience Measure, we’ve reached 36.4m people per week across our owned and operated TV and digital platforms providing a 27.4m incremental contribution to the Corporation’s total.”

India

Laying out an action plan for AIR, an IIT-Bombay report says short wave and medium wave services have few takers and must be scrapped

AIR should phase out short wave and medium wave services, accessed through the once ubiquitous transistors and radio sets, and focus on FM instead, recommends an IIT-Bombay report while giving a thumbs down to the digital DRM technology that the public broadcaster is pushing.

With most people accessing radio on their mobiles or car stereos, only a small fraction of listeners in urban areas use the difficult-to-buy transistors and radio sets, says the technical audit report on All India Radio's short wave and medium wave services.

Barely 10 per cent of people, mostly the elderly, in urban localities listen to short wave or medium wave services, Girish Kumar, professor in IIT-B's electrical engineering department who headed the team conducting the audit for AIR's parent body Prasar Bharati, told DNA.

Digital Radio Mondiale (DRM) receivers, pegged by AIR as a technology replacement for Soviet-era worn-out short and medium wave transmitters, are just too expensive, the report says. Though a DRM transmitter can give higher range than others, installing a larger number of FM transmitters can help cover the entire country.

However, AIR continues to replace short and medium wave transmitters in the country with DRM transmitters even though the technology has few takers in India, sources disclosed.

“During the audit, I visited prominent electronic stores of Mumbai to buy a transistor. However, no transistor, radio set or even a DRM receiver was available there. They are available only in some online sites. But some people in rural areas are still using decade-old radio sets or handheld transistors,” Kumar said.

“That is why our report had strongly recommended shutting down short wave and medium wave services for AIR and augment the number of FM towers instead.” This would help in rural areas too where mobile phones with FM services are increasing.

DRM transmitters, Kumar explained, can offer good range but listeners have to buy a receiver that could be as expensive as Rs.15,000. “Why would people buy a DRM receiver to listen to radio when they can do the same on their mobile phones or their cars?” he asked.

“Even for the newly installed DRM transmitter in Malad, there are barely any takers, both because of expensive receivers and lack of awareness about it,” he said.

In the 11th Plan, Rs.9.29 billion has been earmarked for AIR to go digital.

The new channel, AIR Maitree, that broadcasts programmes to Bangladesh is transmitted through a digital transmitter even though most people in Bangladesh avail FM radio services on their phones and hardly use DRM receivers. There is no feedback gathering mechanism to check if AIR Maitree programmes are being heard in Bangladesh at all, sources admitted.

Audit details:

The audit included field measurements at more than 13,000 locations and above 9,000 people surveys. Most people do not have a good medium wave, short wave radio receivers and the quality of medium wave reception is not as good as FM radio.

In fact, most people interviewed are unaware of AIR's outdated short wave and medium wave services, the report states.

Barring hilly and border areas, medium wave services should be shut in metro and all major cities and the number of FM transmitters should be increased, it says and suggests important programmes on medium wave and short wave services be broadcast via FM radio.

At present, 145 medium wave and 48 short wave transmitters are located in 125 cities of India. Being from the Soviet era, most of the equipment is now worn out. Non-availability of spare parts has added to the problem. As a result, there is poor transmission of signals in most parts of the country.

Pakistan

Director General Pakistan Broadcasting Corporation Khurshid Malik has directed the engineering wing to accelerate work on installation of transmitters in different parts of the country to make signals of transmission stronger and clearer.

Chairing a meeting at National Broadcasting House on Thursday, he said role of Radio Pakistan has become all the more important in prevailing regional environment. Besides further improvement in contents, there is dire need to make signals stronger to extend reach of Radio Pakistan.

He asked the Engineering Wing to speed up work on installation of 100 kW short wave transmitter in Landhi, Karachi and 100 kW medium wave transmitter in Larkana and complete these projects at the earliest.

It was also decided on the direction of Director General to enhance operating power of 100 kW medium wave transmitter in Multan to extend coverage in Southern Punjab with immediate effect.

100 kW transmitters in Lahore, Quetta, and Mirpur will also be run on optimum level in order to counter cross-border propaganda.

Pace of work on installation of FM transmitters for Sautul Quran Channel in Multan, Bannu, Gwadar, Sibbi, Gilgit, and Skardu is also being accelerated for early transmission.

Old FM-101 transmitter installed at Kalar Kahar is being replaced by new one for effective transmission on motorway.

Besides, a new transmitter is being installed at Thandiani in Abbottabad for effective coverage of Hazara Division and CPEC route.

Meanwhile, during a visit to News and Current Affairs Channel, the Director General said main focus should be on bringing further improvement in the contents of the programs. He also emphasized the need for maximum resource sharing amongst different wings of the national broadcaster.

Khurshid Malik said his priority will be on resource generation for the organization.

On the occasion, Director of News Rao Sadiq Ali and Controller Current Affairs Javed Khan Jadoon gave briefing to him about different programs of the current affairs channel.

After four years, Mark Forrest is to leave the networked evening show on BBC Local Radio, to be replaced by Georgey Spanswick.

Georgey currently hosts the show on a Friday, but will become the full time host in the new year. She'll leave the breakfast show on BBC Radio York where she was just last week named Best Local Breakfast Show at the ARIAS.

Mark has decided to move to London so will no longer be in Leeds where the show is made. Mark said: "I'm proud of the show we have produced for the last four years and I'm pleased to be moving on when the audience figures indicate the show is in great shape."

Mark will present his last evening show on Thursday February 2.

The introduction of a networked evening show across BBC Local Radio was a controversial move when it started in 2013, and has seen audience figures between 7pm and 10pm decline as a result.

Georgey, who's also worked for TV-AM, Channel 4 and Yorkshire TV, said: "I've loved presenting the Friday evening show for the last year and a bit. So to be able to present the show five nights a week is fantastic.

"My body clock is going to be all over the place because I'm currently up at the crack of dawn. I will actually miss the early starts, the ease of getting into work and that pre-dawn chorus quiet. And, of course, I will miss everyone at Radio York and the listeners.

"But this is a great opportunity to broadcast to the whole of England. I hope to have a good natter with lots of different people and a good laugh with everyone."

David Holdsworth, the controller of BBC English Regions, said: "I'd like to thank Mark for his hard work and professionalism over the last four years. He has made the evening show an excellent listen. We all wish him well for the future.

"Georgey is one of the brightest talents in local radio – warm, witty and just right for the evening show. I'm sure she'll prove popular with our listeners."

LBC gets boost from Brexit coverage16 October, 2016

LBC, 1152 kHz, the London station claims the fallout from the EU referendum has "got more reaction than at any time in our history" with a surge in calls from listeners and some of its videos getting millions of online views.

James Rea, the managing director of LBC, said social media had "turbo-charged" LBC's video views in the last six months with many of the radio station's biggest interviews now being live-streamed on Facebook Live.

Rea described the last few weeks as "an extraordinary, remarkable" time for news with the Brexit referendum, Conservative and Labour party leadership battles and a slew of dramatic foreign news, including police shootings in the US, a terror attack in Nice and an abortive coup in Turkey.

"It was what LBC was invented for," Rea declared, adding that social media and online video had given the news radio station "the opportunity to take things up another notch and become cross-platform". He said:

"The EU referendum fallout is getting more reaction than at any time in our history. The number of calls has been phenomenal."

He maintained that at certain times "there hasn't been a free line into the building" for listeners to call in with their views. "We have had to bring in extra producers," he said. "There's been such a thirst for information on both sides of the debate. On-air, we've got opinionated presenters and that's where it's got going online."

Rea claimed LBC has been "the most engaged UK radio brand on Facebook and Twitter" as a result of the EU referendum and its monthly reach on Facebook roughly trebled to 30 million in June compared to earlier months in the year.

He said online video content often worked well if it was a "40-second sound bite" but longer clips were also popular. "It depends on how compelling that piece of content is," he explained. Rea said it was important to put content on social platforms. "We can't wait for audiences to come to us," he said. "Our content can bump into them on whatever platform or device they're using."

LBC does not make money out of its social media and online video news clips directly but uses its reach to sell advertisers sponsored video and native ads that can be distributed on social.

LBC's owner, Global Radio, faces increased competition from talkRADIO and talkSPORT as their parent company, Wireless Group, is being bought by Rupert Murdoch's News UK.

"We welcome the competition," Rea said, adding that the £220m acquisition shows "commercial radio is in very good shape".

Other news brands have got a boost from the EU referendum, with some newspapers enjoying a circulation rise of 20% on the weekend after the Brexit result. (<http://www.campaignlive.co.uk/article/lbc-gets-boost-brexit-coverage/1402861>)

Canada news - TTP Media’s CFNV 940 AM begins on-air testing.

After occasional sputters of an audible tone a few hours a day over a few weeks, 940 AM has actual audio for the first time in almost seven years as TTP Media’s first AM radio station has officially begun testing. The programming consists of music in English and French, with a 23-second announcement about the station about every 15 minutes confirming its callsign of CFNV and asking people with reception issues to call 1-855-732-5940. It says the station will launch “progressivement sous peu” or “très bientôt” (the message varies slightly). CFNV will be a French-language talk station when it launches, which the CRTC has said it must do by Nov. 21. The licence was first authorized in 2011, and the deadline extended three times (one more than usual).

The deadline to launch an English station at 600 AM passed on Nov. 9. The CRTC confirms to me it has received an application for an extension to that deadline (which was supposed to be final) but has not made a decision yet.

A third station, a French sports-talk at 850 AM, had its authorization expire this summer with no request for extension.

940 AM, which is assigned to Montréal as a clear channel, so this station will have a very large footprint at night, was last used by AM 940, a Corus-owned station that began as 940 News and kept cutting resources and changing formats until it finally shut down in 2010.

Loomis CA-based Immaculate Heart Radio and Green Bay WI-based Relevant Radio will combine to become Immaculate Heart Media d/b/a Relevant Radio. Immaculate Heart brings 19 stations across six western states including 930 KHJ Los Angeles and 1260 KSFB San Francisco.

Relevant also has 19 stations scattered across ten states including 1430 WNSW New York, 950 WNTB Chicago, 640 WWJZ Philadelphia, and 1330 WLOL Minneapolis. Both groups create programming that is heard on additional Catholic stations nationwide to bring their reach to over 108 stations in 36 states. The two groups have raised \$22 million out of an intended \$30 million over three years to be put towards increasing their programming, outreach, and new media efforts.

Their website states that "The Virginia Department of Transportation (VDOT) operates a network of Highway Advisory Radio transmitters throughout the state to keep motorists informed on traffic and travel conditions and construction information.

PAX116 - en resumé från Parkalompolo 1-7 november 2016

Tisdagen den 1 november var det min tur att åter få åka till Parka. Tillsammans med Per Eriksson från Hököpinge Kyrkby, Alf Persson, Nödinge och Lars Wieden, Göteborg for vi med SAS förmiddagsplan till Kiruna där vi hämtade ut vår rymliga hyrbil. Körde så till metropolen för div shopping och traditionsenlig pizza på torget. På finfina nybyggda vägar körde vi lätt genom såväl mörker som dimma och landade vid lyssnarskolan vid pass halv sju.

Väl installerade på förekommande sätt, avåts sedvanlig medbragd tårta tillsammans med de redan närvarande: Bosse Olofsson och Ben Korbeeck samt Cornel v. Ravenswaj, de två sistnämnda uppflugna från Nederländerna och vilka nöjda avreste redan följande morgon den 2 november.

Första kvällen bjöd eljest inte på några stora överraskningar, men från sydost hörde vi flera klara och fina id från tex AIR, UAE, QAT och ISR. En lagom uppmjukning. Härligt att vara på plats!

Detta var min fjärde expedition till Parka med Perseusmottagare, men min första tillsammans med Jaguar Pro, nu i version 2.7.1. Jag använde precis samma hårdvara som förra året och året dessförinnan, men tidigare års 'hackande' inspelningar var nu historia. Om det berodde på Jaguar och/eller på Nicos nya drivrutin från vårvintern 2016 vet inte jag. Vad jag däremot med säkerhet vet är att Jaguar Pro är ett ovärderligt verktyg att tillgå på en lyssnarexpedition. Jag skulle lätt kunna fylla detta spaltutrymme med förklaringar om varför. Nu väl hemkommen igen, excellerar programmet ytterligare, gjort som det är för effektiv trålning av stora datamängder, i mitt fall nära 7 TB.

Utan Bosses storartade antennunderhåll hade vi inte hört så mycket heller. Vi hade sex antenner till vårt förfogande och de presterade väl allihop. Tack så mycket Bo!

I vanlig ordning ville USA's västkust allra mest, men fick i år konkurrens av östkust och Orinocco.

Den nordliga Alaska/Hawaii-antennen i 355 grader bjöd mig som NDB-lyssnare på två fina överraskningar med en fyr vardera från NT (VQ 326) och AK (AES 390) vilka aldrig tidigare rapporterats i Europa. En handfull nya kanadensare loggades, men visst har även vi fyrlyssnare 'dominanter'. Ett nytt fält med NT:s fyr HI på 361 i DQ10cs loggades och fyllde därmed xQ-ringen.

Många HI-stationer förgyllde flera tidiga eftermiddagar, och Australien hördes väl på X-bands-frekvenserna, men på 1548 överraskade ABC Capricornia, 4QD, med finfin styrka, läsbarhet och kanon id vid flera tillfällen. Tyvärr ingen NZ eller Kiribati denna gång, - heller.

På JPN/NZ-antennen kunde undertecknad höra, för mig, nya National Radio Kampuchea 918 med bra id dessutom stora mängder JAP, KOR och så klart CHN som finns överallt. Även Laos 567 gick samtidigt samt VTN 675 och PAK 1152/1260. Många indier med EE-nyheter.

Vi loggade rätt lite LA, men ingen i gänget hyser något större intresse för de språken, så fynden ligger kvar i sanden. Dock gav de få kvitto på att även den antennen fungerar som den ska. VEN, CLM, PTR och MEX fanns tillsammans med CUB vilka stod som spön i backen.

Men det är väl USA, inkl AK och HI som räknas i Parka samt, i viss mån, CAN.

Detaljerade loggar finns att tillgå på nätet för varje expedition, så jag tänker inte börja rada upp stationerna här. Sydstaterna är alltid svårfångade och så även denna Parkavecka. Konditionerna favoriserade i vanlig ordning västliga och nordliga stater. Fem i tolv, kom så lite östkust i våra trålar.

Mobiltäckningen är nu nära nog fullständig i skolan och alla operatörer utom Tre verkar vara i luften i byn. Med moderna kommunikationsmetoder kom så många rapporter att skrivas på plats och ett flertal QSL anlände elektroniskt redan under expeditionens gång. Sköna nya värld.

Bosse guidade hugade sörlänningar längs koaxer och antenner i Parkaskogen vilken till vår ära pryts med ett fyra centimeter tjockt, vackert snötäcke. I samma skog gjorde vi ett par försök med en av Per medhavd SuperKAZ av Wellbrooks tillverkning. Den fungerade väl i N-S sträckning, men hade ingen chans mot de långa, smala bävrarna. Icke desto mindre hörde vi ett 'flertal' TA på den.

Under de tystaste middagstimmarna, medan mottagarna spelade in för säkerhets skull, for vi en dag till Finland. I Muonio kompletterade vi färskvaror och fikade hos rundhyllt och vänlig tös från Schweiz. Personligt rekord i renskådning sattes med rent av renar i var och varenda dikesren. Väl hemma igen erhöles underhållning i skolkorridoren, Där spelade byns duktige enmansunderhållare Ejlert på sin fina Fendergitarr och sjöng vackra visor på tornedalsmål – Sveriges enda finska språkenklav omger skolan.

I år hade vi samlat oss kring ett gemensamt matlag. En satsning som slog väl ut på flera sätt. Först och främst var det gott och trevligt att äta samma mat runt bordet men det innebar även att samkvämet runt blev enhetligare och störningarna färre för den som förr inte åt, utan lyssnade.

Tisdag morgon var det dags att tacka Bosse och sätta sig i bilen efter väl förättat värv. Många timmars inspelningar ligger välemballerade i handbagaget och kommer att glädja under många kommande höst- och vinterdagar. Tre timmar senare har Vittangi bjudit 'lite bättre kaffe' på OK/Q8-macken och bilen är återlämnad fulltankad och tömd på resgods. Trots datastrul på ARN kom alla hem i utsatt tid. Borta bra men ... ja, du vet. Trålen väntar.

Säkert vet du också att SDXF nu sponsrar sina medlemmar med en veckas Parkavistelse per år. Det redan mest prisvärda sättet att tillbringa sin DX-hobby, med hobbyfränder och ett guldläge, med sex nära kilometerlånga bävvar, är nu tusen kronor billigare efter årsmötesbeslut. Två år måste du ha varit medlem för att åtnjuta den bonusen.

I juli 2017 släpps den nya Parkasäsongens bokningslista. Om liv och lem medger, så kommer jag att finnas bland nästa säsongens radionjutare i Parkalompolo. Det finns gott om plats där uppe till dig också, även denna säsong. Vi ses i Parkalompolo!

Good morning Jim:

I was finally able to get to your e-mail from the 3rd of November this weekend and then I received your letter and CD in the mail on Saturday to verify what you heard.

Yes! You were to listening to KSMO Radio, 1,000 KHZ, AM 1340, Salem, Missouri as recorded on your CD and MP3 file. To verify, I have enclosed a snapshot of the music log for that day (161024) with the songs you heard hi-lighted for the verification. The time you actually heard though was Central **Daylight** Time, not Central **Standard** Time if you need that for your records. That change didn't happen until November 6th.

Thank you for sending that CD to me as I had an instance where I was in St. Louis at about 11:30 at night by the St. Louis International Airport in 1988 when I accidentally hit my station on my push button setting and there KSMO was, just as loud and clear as if I were sitting in my home. Our signal usually doesn't go any further to the northeast than Sullivan, some 60 miles away from where I was so it caught me by surprise. I pulled off the road and the signal stayed strong for about five minutes before fading away. Of course at that time (which was long before cell phones), I couldn't record it as proof and people today still don't believe that happened.

Good luck on finding other US stations and if you (or anyone in radio listeners group) happen to catch KSMO again, just let me know and I will be glad to verify what your heard.
