”Har hört det mesta som går i rundradioväg här i Sverige från 1976 då jag kom i klorna på dx-hobbyn. I början av 90-talet gjordes en del försök med långa beverages uppe på Hunneberg utanför Vänersborg ihop med PÅV Peter Åsberg, Vänersborg, som jag blev bra bekant med men som gick bort alldeles för tidigt. JB, Johan Berglund blev jag också bra bekant med som då bodde i sin stuga utanför Trollhättan, dit jag ofta åkte ut och hälsade på med moped innan jag fick körkort för bil.

Lyssnade annars väldigt mycket på Luxy och Caroline på den tiden när det begav sig, numera står Radio Seagull 1602 på här i shacket när jag inte rattar efter lokala britter.

Utrustningen består av ett antal olika ICOM:s IC 7400, IC 706, IC 718, IC 7000. På hyllan ligger en Elad FTM S2, än så länge inte inkopplad, ska bara skaffa en separat dator. Den ska igång till hösten och därmed ny teknik att lära sig. Vad gäller antenn så finns sedan en vecka tillbaka en beverage på 300 meter i 210 grader. Nu under sommaren ska 500 meter upp i 55-60 kompassgrader mot Japan-Korea.

Jag har missat dryga 40 NA-säsonger på grund av bristande antennlägen och andra intressen inom radion, men nu när jag fått ett skapligt qth för mellanvågslyssning mitt inne i Borås så beslutade jag mig för att förkovra mig i antennteknik kring beverage som jag tidigare kommit i kontakt med.

Är 53 år fyllda, jobbar som grafiker/tidningstryckare på ett större tidningstryckeri med nattjänstgöring så det är inte alla nätter jag kan vara hemma i radiolyan.

Rattat på mellanvåg har jag alltid gjort när jag på ett antal resor till Asien haft med mig portabla mottagare. ## Ofcom News

### Five New AM Licences awarded .....1 June, 2017

Here are the 5 licences awarded by Ofcom:

- **Ark AM** (Noah’s Ark, Glasgow) will serve the needs of Glasgow’s diverse Muslim communities.
- **Carillon Wellbeing Radio** (Carillon Wellbeing Limited) is for people in West Leicestershire who have, or who are at risk of developing, long term health conditions.
- **Radio Caroline** (Radio Caroline AM Broadcasting Ltd) will broadcast a wide range of album music from the 1960s to the present day. It is for people aged 45+ in Suffolk and northern parts of Essex.
- **Radio Ninesprings** (Radio Ninesprings) will bring a locally-focussed community radio service for the people of Yeovil and the south Somerset District area.
- **Radio Seerah** (Seerah Academy) will be a station for the diverse Muslim and ethnic communities of inner Leicester.

In its application Radio Caroline had asked for 1 kW of power - compared to the usual 50 watts - that community services operate at. It proposed to cover an area bounded by Ipswich in the South, Bury St Edmunds and Stowmarket in the West, Saxmundham to the East and Diss to the North. The station’s application said it would broadcast most of the programmes from Kent and from the Ross Revenge ship using 4G.

Peter Moore from Radio Caroline told RadioToday: “It is our ambition to get on air by August 14th as that would be the most fitting date to take the whole story full circle and it may be the last significant anniversary where most of the people who were there at the start can get together again. But, the application process took a while and we don’t have as much time as we would have wished. We will do our best – it would be a pity to miss that date.”

Making the decision to award a licence, the regulator said: “Ofcom noted that the application was from a well-established group with a long history of providing a radio service, and was satisfied that it had demonstrated its ability to maintain a service. Ofcom considered that the service would broaden choice in relation to existing radio services available in the area by having a strong album focus. The applicant provided evidence of support for the service including a Radio Caroline Support Group that has supported the station for over 20 years, and has raised funds to support the service. As part of its accountability arrangements, at least one member of the Radio Caroline Support Group will be elected to the licensee’s board. The station will offer training in its ship-board studios.”

In a statement on its website, Radio Caroline told listeners: “We are pleased to announce that Ofcom have just informed us that our application for an AM licence has been approved and that a licence will be awarded. Further details will be sent to us by Ofcom in due course. Power levels and frequency are yet to be decided. This is the end of – or a further step in – a process started by Bob Lawrence in 2010 and enthusiastically supported by Tracey Crouch MP. We thank them both and further thank the many other people who have helped along the way.

There are many preparations to be made and these may take some time. I am sure we will make further announcements in the future. The basis of our application was that our traditional heartland was Essex and Suffolk, where the signal from our ships made first landfall and that we wished to entertain on AM, an audience that we have not been able to serve in this way since 1990. We said that this audience may hear music radio of a style they remember and in some cases presented by the same people they remember. That in essence is what we intend to do.”

10 June. “We can now announce that our AM frequency will be 648 kHz with a power of 1000 watts. This is ERP or simply the power radiated by the aerial.”

A transmitter was imported from the Continent a few days ago and is now being modified to suit the frequency. There are further hurdles, but as you can see progress is being made.”

Its taken Radio Caroline 53 years to get an AM licence and it was perceived as a threat to the BBC for many years. Ironically 648 kHz was best known for transmitting the BBC World Service in English around the clock on 648 kHz from September 1982 until March 2011 from the Orfordness transmitting station on the Suffolk coast.

### **BBC Pirate BBC Essex .....30 May 2017**

The BBC & Pharos Trust are pleased to confirm that the LV18 will again be the host for Pirate BBC Essex. The station will run 12th to 14th August 2017 and will mark, on 14th August, the 50th anniversary of the Marine Offences Act which closed most pirate radio stations.

Pirate BBC Essex programmes from 9am – 3pm on Monday 14th live from the LV18 on all frequencies (for the first time!) including presenters Johnnie Walker, Roger ‘Twiggy’ Day, Tom Edwards and Norman St John. Other surprise Pirate guests expected!

- 600 CFQR Montréal QC has begun testing at various times with Open Carrier or simulcasting (mostly music) from CFNV's web site. CFQR is 10 kW's day, 5 night. (IRCA's DX Monitor 54/34)
- 610 CKRW Whitehorse YT - The Yukon, always a very difficult catch, just became even more so. The CRTC has approved an application by Klondike Broadcasting to take their Whitehorse station CKRW 610 AM off the air. They stated that the structural integrity of the existing tower for CKRW had been compromised and posed a potential safety risk. As a result, they intend to remove the tower and submit an application to operate CKRW-FM as an originating station on a permanent basis. So goes the last station in the Yukon with any kind of power. - 610 CKYL Peace River AB - approved to shut down their AM transmitter and switch their FM nested repeater to a full power replacement. (IRCA's DX Monitor 54/34)
- 610 CHNL Kamloops BC - speculation that new owners Newcap will apply for 50 kW day and night now that CKYL and CKRW Whitehorse YT are going dark and CJAT Trail went dark over 20 years ago. (IRCA's DX Monitor 54/34)
- 940 CFNV Montréal QC - so far, off the air whenever CFQR-600 is testing (see above), and sometimes when they are not, as they share the same transmitter site. (IRCA's DX Monitor 54/34)
- 1210 VOAR Mount Pearl NL will move to 94.9 FM. (Andy Reid via Ydun's Medium Wave Info 29.6.2017)

## USA

As part of its planned revamp of all media regulations, the FCC has issued a Notice of Proposed Rulemaking to eliminate the main studio rule. The rulemaking would end to requirement for every broadcast station to have a main studio in or near its city of license and the requirement that it be staffed during normal business hours and be able to originate programming. The FCC has granted many non-commercial networks such as Educational Media Foundation waivers against the main studio rule, allowing the company to operate all of its stations basically as just a box in a rack room with all programming coming from their handful of studios. In theory should the rulemaking be approved, commercial operators can now do the same, eliminating all local offices and have all of their programming coming from a few studios. The FCC also announced it will begin a review of its rules applicable to all media entities. (From Radio Insight via NRC DX News 84/16)

- 1330 WRCA Watertown MA back on 1330 kHz. Andrew Brade writes 5.5.2017 "It was there again this morning with an ID at 0403, but again not really good enough. I Colombia fungerade det. Två hallåmän på FM-stationen **Tropicana** i Bucaramanga avskedades för att de varit fula i munnen. Inte bara en gång utan vid upprepade tillfällen, och även efter att de själva som man nu säger på svenska fått skit för det.

Tidigare fick man inte vara hallåman i Colombia utan föregående utbildning. Det gällde att få godkänt inte bara i uttal och grammatik utan även i hyfs och allmänbildning. I dag hör man inte längre hallåmännen stolt annonsera sina licensnummer.

Det framgår inte vad för slags fräckisar som bollats runt i etern, men det bör ha varit grovkalibriga skämt som potentiellt kunde skada bolaget (Caracol), för det var stationsledningen som tog beslutet.

## ”Påvekorset” fick antennerna på fall



## Greetings From Norway: Tucson Radio Waves Travel to the Arctic

Radio enthusiasts in Nordic countries picked up on AZPM's signal, and got in touch.

Arizona Public Media always hopes for feedback, but our interest jumped one morning in December when a string of messages arrived from listeners in far-off lands.


The messages all had things in common: They were enthusiastic, they contained a recording, and they bore a request asking that someone here at AZPM confirm that the recording was, in fact, us.

The listeners had picked up our signal in Kongsfjord, Norway. Our AM frequency traveled around 5,000 miles to the very north of that country, and of the continent, to arrive at the Arctic fishing village.

One of those messages came from OJ Sagdahl. He and two friends, Bjarne Mjelde and Ole Forr, count themselves as part of a worldwide group of radio enthusiasts known as DXers. Their particular brand of this hobby is to build large antennas and “catch” signals from radio stations in distant places.

“I would say it’s definitely our main hobby for all of us. It’s like a stamp collector or coin collector who finds this really rare coin. So we keep lists and statistics - kind of competing partly with each other and also our friends in Sweden and Finland,” Sagdahl told AZPM over Skype from Copenhagen, where he was for work.



While none of them lives in Kongsfjord, Sagdahl said, they operate their antenna project at a summer home there that belongs to Mjelde. The antennas are monitoring signals 24 hours a day, with remote-controlled receivers.

Arizona is one of those rare coins for DXers in Nordic countries, and Forr was the first to hear on their receivers in Kongsfjord, Sagdahl said

“One of us discovered an unusual signal on 1550 AM, with NPR programming ... after a few hours we realized it was actually **KUAZ in Arizona**, which has been on the long-time wanted list because it’s a really difficult station to get.”

The Arctic fishing village is an ideal place for these signal catchers. Darkness allows for the propagation of the signal, and all the conditions must work together to “catch” a rare station. “If it had been summer, it wouldn’t have happened.”

That's because sun and solar activity hamper the signals, Sagdahl said. Summer's round-the-clock sun means it's a wintertime activity. Plus, they have to remove the antennas in the summer because it's also a grazing area for reindeer returning from the mountain

Sagdahl said it's not the first time Arizona Public Media has been picked up in Nordic countries, but it's pretty rare.

“Arizona is one of the most difficult states to catch in the U.S., probably because it's so far, and there are also relatively few stations in Arizona.

I've been collecting stations for many, many years. I have more than 2,000 U.S. and Canadian stations and only 21 from Arizona. So Arizona is really a very exclusive state for us.”

Sagdahl followed the path of many radio hobbyists. He bought his first radio when he was 7, and at around age 12 realized he could send letters to radio stations, who would respond with “QSL” confirmation cards.

He's been doing it ever since, and sought out more challenges as he grew older, he said. With virtually all of the world's radio stations available to stream online, what compels these DXers?

“Some stations that we write to, they don't really care. And they don't find it that exciting that we hear them because we could have listened to them on the internet. But for us it's not the same to listen to the signal on the internet compared to catching it with real radio waves.”

The responses from AZPM employees is all part of the experience, he said.

“These are also the things that made it great fun to be a DXer.”

# Muséet som lever för vågorna

Dyker kanske farbror Sven upp i sin brevlåda? Eller ska Vildanden börja klaga, hon som fick sin make skjuten i de nordliga landen? Om nu inte Hyllands puck gli-der-in-i-mååål? Fast det var väl i teve han skrek så våldsamt?

Vi travar runt bland varvsbyggnaderna på Hisingen och undrar samtidigt vad som kommer att fylla våra öron när vi väl når museet. Jazz vore inte dumt, gärna Smoke Rings där ju Leif Andersons rökiga röst band ihop numren.

Så hittar vi Radiomuseet och kliver in i ett ofantligt, avlångt rum med gamla apparater från golv till tak, museets långhjärta. Vi har aldrig sett så många radior, som det väl lär heta, det måste vara flera hundra. Väggen verkar nästan tapetserad med modeller, kronologiskt ordnade från tidigt 1900-tal till omkring 1970. Då tog transistorerna men framför allt teven över och branschen tvärsvängde.

Så blir det natt i Tunisien, vi hör hur Gillespie blåser i sin uppsvingda trumpet. Inte dumt det heller. Tonerna är från 1946.

Det börjar annars med åtta trathögtalare, stora lurar som liknar svarta blommor. Det tidigaste 1900-talet är företrätt med en rad rätt anspråkslösa lådor. Här och var ligger skivfodral bland apparaterna. Där till exempel har vi sångerskan Ingeborg Nyberg, hon som hade så vackra flätor.

Det finns ett fyrtiotal grammofonmöbler mitt i rummet också, stora skrytpjäser som måste ha dominerat vardagsrummen på sin tid. Vi letar genast efter den bulliga typ med välvtt lock som vi hade i vårt hem på 50-talet.

Då börjar Alice Babs sjunga ”Vad tar ni för valpen där i fönstret?”, som alltid klockrent och försilvrat. I bakgrunden hör vi valpen gläfsa.

Nej, vi upptäcker inte vår gamla bullmöbel. Däremot springer vi på den skrivspelare som stod i vårt pojkrum. På gavlarna kunde man spänna fast en sorts väldiga plastöron. Ljudet blev inte bättre av det, man fick snarare en känsla av att radion stod där och lyssnade på sig själv.

Just en sådan DUX-radio säljer museet förresten för 600 kronor, ser vi på hemsidan! Men utan plastöron. Man saluför vid vårt besök ett sextiotal apparater, alla genomgångna och översedda.

Därefter hör vi hur överstarna tar över i Grekland 1967. Jaktplan sveper in över Aten och det rasslar från stridsvagnar på gatorna, meddelar reportern.

Ett ytterhölje på en gammal trotjänare är avlyft och man kan beskåda radions inälvor. MOTSTÅND står det under modellen. Men det förstår vi inte riktigt. Vi känner i alla fall inget sådant. Tvärtom. Vi tar gärna emot alla signaler och intryck. Och just nu börjar Brita Borg sjunga om att hon ska ta med sig morfar ut i kväll. Strax därpå refererar Jerring från en flygplats där man inviger världens första polarlinje till USA.

Ett glasskåp innehåller hundratals radiorör av alla typer. Det största liknar ett flaskskepp, något ser ut som en kaffebryggare. Då är vi inne på avdelningen för fartygsradio. Det tågar vi förbi och hamnar i stället på teveavdelningen. I en ruta åker en skara damer skidor. Vi tror först att det snöar men det är bilden som blir så grymig.

Teve på Radiomuseet? Det känns lite som överkurs. Men vi stannar förstås till när Sten-Åke spexar och sjunger. Evryhopa, ropar han. Man har inrett ett teverum med soffa, tevekanna på ett lågt bord och askfat med pipa - som det såg ut på 60-talet. Där sätter vi oss i en grön fåtölj och skrattar en stund åt Cederhöks ädla buskis.

Men när vi kommer in i det fjärde rummet börjar vi storkna. Här finns Militärradio, Mätinstrument, Kontrollrum och Flygradio. Vi var inte riktigt beredda på detta kolossala omfång. Radiomuseet är en avlång hangar och man har utnyttjat varje millimeter.

Så döms Stig Wennerströms till livstids straffarbete i en apparat. Och Zarah Leander sjunger om ett glas champagne och en minnesvärd kyss. Då har vi redan börjat leta efter det gröna ögat. En gång i tiden kunde ju radion ta oss runt i världen, till Kalundborg, Hilversum, Warszawa och andra främmande orter.

Det där magiska ögat stönade väl inte men avgav egendomliga ljud och grimaserade. När det sedan klarnade flödade musik och röster in i rummet. Vi får hjälp av ett par mannar som skakar liv i en stor apparat och så kan vi beundra det där ögat igen.

Stora delar av museet är förstås inrättat för specialister. Men den omfångsrika avdelningen om rundradion, museets centrala del, måste ändå roa varje människa med hjärta i kroppen. Och de som inte är radioter kan få hjälp av kunniga herrar i huset.

Så får vi lyssna på en fonograf från 1906. Det raspar och knastrar en del men upplevelsen blir inte sämre av det, den blir bättre. Missljudet ska vara med, det är ju historien vi hör, dess knastrande vingslag.


