Men saknaden efter 317-gradesantennen var märkbar den här natten.

Konditionererna höll i sig till halvtiotiden svensk tid.

Torolf Johnsson 18.11.2018:

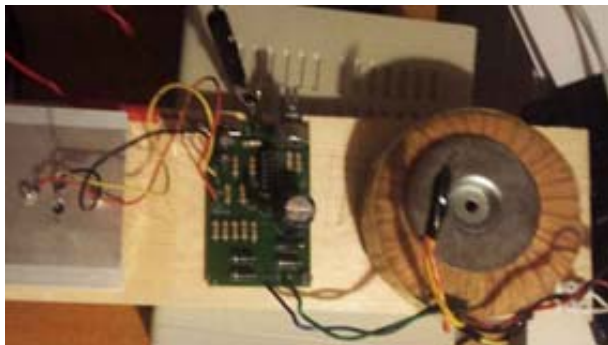

Ofcom News

Network Breakfast Shows Allowed26 October, 2018

Ofcom has updated its Localness Guidelines for commercial radio stations and will now allow a local commercial radio station to network its breakfast show.

The new guidelines reduce the weekday commitment of seven hours locally made programmes produced to three between 6am and 7pm, and removes to the requirement to include breakfast in those hours, if local news is provided at least hourly throughout the same period. Stations will need to request a change to their Format for this to happen, so no immediate changes are expected.

Ofcom's Approved Areas have also changed to regionals rather than counties – something which was expected via deregulation. Ofcom is currently re-consulting on the approved areas for Scotland and Wales.

BBC News

BBC Listening Figures25 October, 2018

The latest listening figures for Radio have been published. This covers the quarter ending September 2018. At the BBC, all BBC Radio's weekly reach over the period (Q3, 25 June – 16 September 2018) was 34.3 million (34.5m last quarter and 34.9m last year) and a share of 51.7% (51.7% last quarter and 52.1% last year).

In September 2018 there was a record 26.5 million downloads of BBC podcasts in the UK. Of these, 14.7 million (also a record) were Radio 4 podcasts such as The Ratline and Friday Night Comedy. Radio 5 Live also had a record 4.7 million downloads of popular podcasts such as That Peter Crouch Podcast and Flintoff, Savage and the Ping Pong Guy.

BBC Radio 1 posted a reach of 9.6 million listeners (from 9.24m last quarter and 9.69m last year) – which rises to 10.56 m when listeners aged 10 and over are included (up on the quarter by 308,000 and on the year by 9,000) – while the network's share of listening was 6% (from 5.9% last quarter and 5.9% last year). The Radio 1 Breakfast Show now attracts 5.75 million listeners (all listeners aged 10+), which is 79,000 fewer than last quarter and up 465,000 since last year.

BBC Radio 2's weekly audience was 14.64 million (from 14.94m last quarter and 15.36m last year) while the station's share of listening was 17.1% (17.9% last quarter and 17.5% last year). The Chris Evans Breakfast Show attracted 8.82 million listeners per week, compared to 9.04m last quarter and 9.35m last year.

BBC Radio 3's audience was 1.93 million (from 1.91m last quarter and 1.96m last year) and its share was 1.2% (1.1% last quarter and 1.1% last year).

BBC Radio 4 posted a weekly reach of 10.64 million during the quarter (10.60m last quarter and 11.22m last year) and a share of 11.6% (11.7% last quarter and 11.8% last year). The Today programme (Monday – Saturday) has 6.98m million listeners each week, it was also 6.98m last quarter and 7.17m last year. In 2017 there was a record number of listeners during a period of significant news events with listening figures returning to usual levels. Over the last year we've seen approximately 15% increase in online live streaming and on demand listening. Alongside some of our popular news podcasts, such as Political Thinking and Brexitcast, it's clear listeners turn to the BBC for trusted and comprehensive news coverage and are increasingly listening digitally.

BBC Radio 5 live posted a reach of 5.03 million listeners (4.73 m last quarter and 5.07m last year) and a share of 3.4% (3.1% last quarter and 3.4% last year).

Amongst digital-only stations, BBC Radio 1Xtra had a reach of 1.04m weekly listeners across the period (from 1.03m last quarter and 1.08 last year) – which rises to 1.12m when listeners aged 10 + are included, BBC Radio 6 Music drew 2.52 million listeners (from 2.44m last quarter and 2.43m last year), BBC Radio

4 Extra attracted 2.01 million listeners per week (from 1.96 m last quarter and 2.15m last year), and BBC Radio 5 live sports extra posted 1.67m listeners (from 1.17m last quarter and 1.64m last year).

BBC Asian Network drew 631,000 listeners, compared to 672,000 listeners last quarter and 662,000 last year.

The BBC World Service posted a weekly UK audience of 1.48million (from 1.51 m last quarter and 1.49 m last year) (www.radiotoday.co.uk)

Don't like Changes to the Programme?22 October, 2018

Some listeners are unhappy with recent changes to BBC Radio 2's Drivetime show. But is it really that bad, or are radio audiences particularly resistant to change?

Chris Evans, Ken Bruce, Jeremy Vine, Steve Wright and Simon Mayo have several things in common. All are men. All are white. All are over the age of 50. And all present a daytime show on Radio 2.

But the station's male-skewing weekday schedule was given a shake-up in January, when it was announced that evening presenter Jo Whiley would be joining Mayo's programme as a co-host. "You can see what the bosses at Radio 2 were thinking," wrote Catherine Nixey in The Times. "Drivetime looks like such an easy gig.

"All you have to do is play a few records, sound genial when Glenda rings in with a request and produce a bit of banter between the traffic and travel. It's everyman radio. Surely every man - even every woman - can do it? They cannot. And Whiley certainly can't."

Both Whiley and Mayo are experienced presenters with decades of BBC radio behind them. But listeners soon complained at a lack of chemistry between the new pairing. An online petition called "Bring back Simon Mayo and the dream team" gathered more than 10,000 signatures. The presenter himself admitted that the upheaval had been "difficult and upsetting".

"We acknowledge some regular listeners are unhappy with the changes," Radio 2 said in its official response to complaints. "Every new show needs time to settle down and so we hope listeners will continue to listen and give it a chance." But listeners were not reassured, and the complaints kept coming.

However after just 2 months Simon Mayo is to leave BBC Radio 2 over his pairing with Jo Whiley. The DJ today announced he would depart to spend more time writing novels, after a troubled few months for the drivetime show.

A source close to the show conceded on Monday that there had been "difficulties", but played down reports of a rift between the co-hosts, who have been friends for 25 years. Announcing his departure earlier, Mayo defended Whiley against "appalling abuse" directed at her on social media. (www.telegraph.co.uk)

Commercial Radio News

Tougher Standards for Gambling ads2 October, 2018

The Committee of Advertising Practice has published stringent guidelines that must be followed going forward for radio stations carrying gambling adverts.

The move is to ensure that vulnerable people aren't targeted via ads which offer bonuses and promotions which would be urgent calls to action.

CAP, which is the sister group to the Advertising Standards Agency, is looking to ensure that all requirements are met by those producing ads to be played on UK radio stations, or they could face punishments such as a ban. CAP is looking to stop any harm coming to UK based consumers listening to the radio, especially through ads which suggest offers are limited time wise.

Newspapers invest in Radio10 October, 2018

When Chris Evans announced this month that he was leaving BBC Radio 2 for Virgin Radio, casual observers may have been confused about how a digital-only station that attracts a few hundred thousand listeners could afford to poach a presenter who earns £1.6m a year and reaches 9 million listeners a week on his BBC breakfast show.

What they probably didn't realise is that Evans' hire is part of a largely overlooked decision by Rupert Murdoch's News UK business to invest heavily in the booming British commercial radio industry, hedging against the ageing readership of its print outlets such as the Sun.

“News UK are keen to diversify from newspapers,” said Matt Deegan, a radio consultant who works for Folder Media. “Radio is a pretty good margin business if you can keep control of your costs. It diversifies away from newsprint and allows them to grow advertising.”

Deegan said Evans’ recruitment was part of a strategy by News UK to make Virgin the biggest commercial radio station in the country. He said the plan required “good content, excellent marketing and an aggressive story” to persuade the public to tune in.

Spending is up across Wireless Group, which operates Murdoch’s UK radio brands. Its flagship station TalkSport outbid the BBC for the radio rights to the England cricket team’s forthcoming tours of Sri Lanka, the West Indies and South Africa, meaning there will be no Test Match Special coverage. The sister station TalkRadio has added Matthew Wright, the former Channel 5 presenter, to a lineup that already includes Eamonn Holmes, and further signings are expected.

The addition of a radio audience, especially the younger listeners that TalkSport attracts, helps the News UK sales team when pitching to advertisers who are less interested in print products. Wireless Group stations will soon be based within the same central London building as News UK’s print newspapers.

With the majority of radio listening now taking place through digital devices – aided by the ubiquity of in-car DAB radios – commercial radio groups are increasingly confident of investing in stations that are not available on FM. In the last decade the UK industry has been dominated by two companies, Global and Bauer, who between them control stations such as Classic FM and Magic and have also combined dozens of smaller local stations into new quasi-national networks such as Capital and Hits, eating into the BBC’s audience share.

These companies have shown themselves willing to throw money around, such as when Global’s LBC pinched Eddie Mair from Radio 4. BBC and News UK sources suggested to the Guardian that Evans had also been in negotiations with Global about working for one its stations before plumping for Virgin. A spokesperson for Global declined to comment on the speculation.

Wireless Group, stuck in third place in the market, has turned to old brand names that listeners may recognise. The Virgin Radio that Evans is joining is not the same station that he worked for, bought, sold and then sued in the late 1990s and early 2000s. That station was rebranded as Absolute Radio in 2008. The current Virgin Radio, operated by Wireless under licence from Richard Branson, only started broadcasting in 2016.

The ability to cross-promote stations in News UK’s other media outlets means readers of the Sun can expect to see positive coverage of Evans when he joins Virgin Radio in the new year.

Robert Thomson, News Corp’s global chief executive, told a conference last month that the acquisition of Wireless Group was working out “very, very favourably for us” given the potential for commercial growth.

Deegan said: “It’s easy sometimes to think of radio as a Cinderella medium. But its commercial and audience success is why everyone’s quite bullish.”

Murdoch’s big radio signings

Chris Evans - The Radio 2 breakfast show host was said to have been upset that his salary was made public in a series of pay disclosures and, having just had twins with his wife, is looking for a new challenge at Virgin Radio, where he will be tasked with helping to lift the station out of obscurity.

Matthew Wright - The presenter quit Channel 5’s The Wright Stuff this year after years as a daytime TV staple. He’s now presenting the afternoon show on TalkRadio, which is taking on Global’s LBC.

Eamonn Holmes - The former Sky News Sunrise host now presents the drive-time programme on TalkRadio, where he sits on a schedule that includes Julia Hartley-Brewer, Iain Lee and the unlikely Murdoch employee George Galloway. (www.theguardian.co.uk)

Mexico

Here is a list of 152 Mexican stations that have informed me (via Facebook message or email) that they have turned off their AMs. I believe the actual number of Mexican stations that have left AM is close to 600, but the 152 listed here have specifically told me that they have finished migrating to FM and turned off their AM. It's possible that one or two individual stations may have answered my question incorrectly, but I believe this list is extremely close to 100% accurate.

In a handful of cases, these old AM frequencies have been auctioned off to new licensees, so it is likely we will see new stations on a few of these channels in the years ahead.

Do you speak Telugu? Welcome to America

Claim: Telugu is the fastest growing language in the US.

Verdict: Yes it is, according to a study by an American think tank. The number of speakers of Telugu, a south Indian language, has grown by 86% in the last seven years. However, it is still outside the top 20 of the most widely-spoken languages other than English.

Think of the most commonly-spoken languages other than English in the United States and this one from southern India may not spring to mind.

The number of US residents speaking Telugu rose by 86% between 2010 and 2017, according to an online video by the World Economic Forum.

The video referred to a study by the US-based Centre for Immigration Studies, which analysed census data to look at the pace at which languages are being spoken in America.

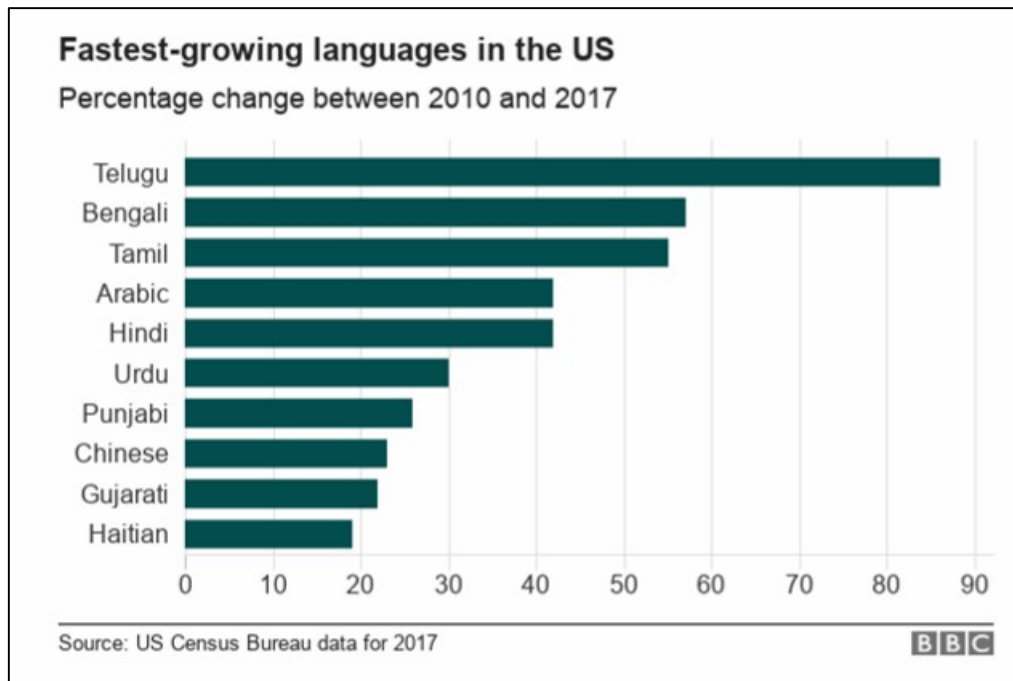
So what's behind the rise of Telugu?

Telugu is mainly spoken in the south Indian states of Andhra Pradesh and Telangana. They have a combined population of 84 million people. It's the fourth most spoken language in India, according to the 2011 census.

The study on languages spoken in the US used data from the American Community Survey and compared the number of people who said they spoke a language other than English at home in 2010 and 2017.

Last year there were more than 400,000 Telugu speakers in the US - nearly double the number in 2010.

Out of the top 10 fastest-growing languages in America, seven are from South Asia.



So why Telugu?

A lot of this can be attributed to the links forged between the city of Hyderabad and the US engineering and technology industries, says Prasad Kunisetty, founder of the Telugu People Foundation, a non-profit organisation in the US. Mr Kunisetty moved to the US in 2001 seeking a career in the IT sector.

The rapid growth of information technology in the mid-1990s led to a huge demand for software engineers, he said.

Many were recruited from Hyderabad, the biggest Telugu-speaking city. Both Telugu-speaking states together now have more than 800 engineering colleges.

The city has become a major hub for the technology and engineering industry in India and has been sending students to the US in droves.

Can English remain the 'world's favourite' language?

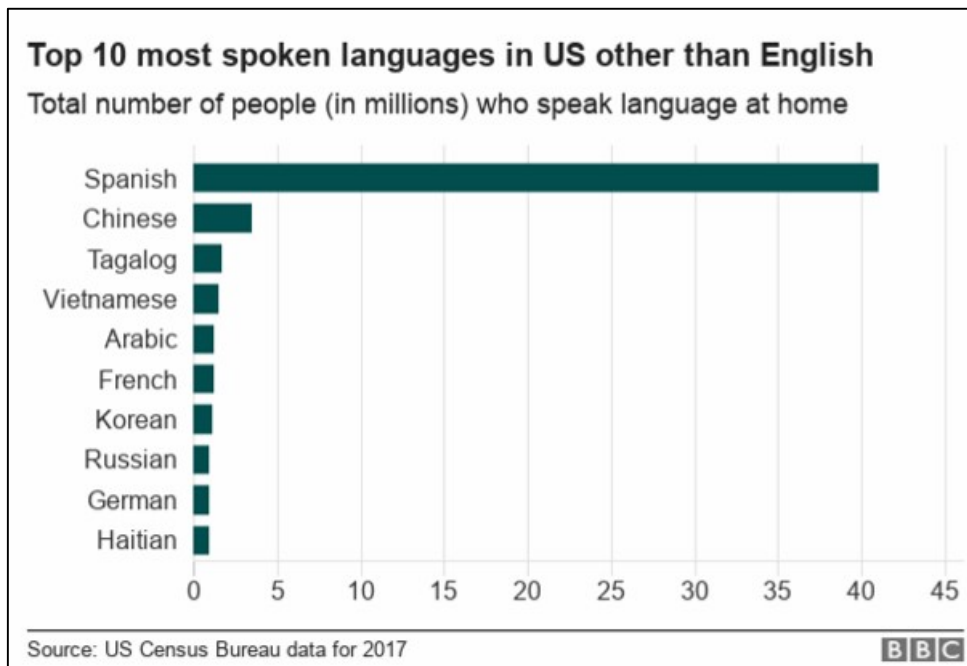
How many words do you need to speak a language?

Down the years Telugu-speaking Americans have continued to hire software engineers from Andhra Pradesh and Telangana.

Many Indians benefit from the H-1B visa scheme, which provides work visas to thousands of foreigners each year often in the technology sector. An estimated 70% go to Indian workers. It allows recipients of the visas to apply for permanent residency status.

Notable US-based Telugu speakers include the first Indian-American Miss America Nina Davuluri and the current Microsoft CEO Satya Nadella.

Why a new US visa bill is causing panic in India



The rise of Telugu is significant as a percentage increase but it started from a low base compared to other languages.

There were more new speakers of Spanish (up to four million more), Chinese, Arabic and Hindi between 2010 and 2017, according to the Centre for Immigration Studies.

Of the more than 60 million people that speak a language other than English out of the total population of about 320 million, the vast majority speak Spanish.

Out of the most commonly spoken South Asian languages, Hindi is first, followed by Urdu, Gujarati and then Telugu.

The number of people who speak French and German at home has declined. The number of Italian speakers has decreased by more than 200,000 in the last decade.

About 80% of the Telugu-speakers surveyed said they speak English very well.

However, one shortcoming of the census data is that the respondents are asked how well they speak English and not about proficiency in other languages, says Jennifer Leeman, a professor of linguistics at George Mason University.

"It's hard to know the non-English proficiency of those people who speak English well, especially if they were born in the US or immigrated as children."

Car Radio-AM No More?

Your Tesla can go 0 to 60 in 2.5s but can't get AM radio!

Electric-powered motors interfere with AM reception, prompting some car makers to drop the dashboard option; 'I was so mad I told them to take the car back!

Cars and AM radio go back a long way, but there's a rough road ahead for the old travel buddies. The same types of electric-powered motors that propel Teslas past 150 mph and the Chevy Bolt as far as 238 miles on a charge, are a total buzz kill for AM reception.

Music cartridges didn't see it off. Neither did cassettes, nor CDs. But AM radio in cars might just have met its nemesis in the future of road transport.

It seems it's about to be killed off by electric-powered motors, according to the Wall Street Journal: what drives Teslas at speeds that match many petrol-driven cars, and the Chevy Bolt well over 200 miles on a single charge, also turns AM reception on the move into unlistenable static.

The result is that electric car makers are starting to leave out the analogue option entirely.

A General Motors spokeswoman said the manufacturer was aware of the problem with the Bolt and had "taken steps", but didn't elaborate.

Experts say the problem is caused because electric vehicles produce electromagnetic frequencies on the same wavelength as AM signals – that produces a nasty buzzing and cause the radio signal to fade in and out.

"You get two signals that literally collide into each other and cancel each other out before the antenna even receives the signal," Brian McKay, head of engine innovation and technology at the North American operations of Continental, told the Journal.

And as electric motors are designed to be ever more powerful, so the interference worsens. And rather than try and solve the problem, many car makers have decided to simply drop AM radios from their electric vehicles.

Honda no longer offers them on its hybrid electric Acura NSX sports car. And Tesla has now removed AM radios from all its current models. Instead, drivers have to settle for an internet-based radio service, plus FM radio, optional HD radio, and Bluetooth to smartphones for streaming music or radio stations digitally.

It's another blow for AM stations, many of which have already been hit by steadily declining ad revenue.

But, while the number might be up for AM in cars of the future, that doesn't mean radio in other forms has lost its appeal, even in cars.

According to Nielsen, more Americans still tune into AM/FM radio than any other platform, and 93% of US adults listen to radio every week — "more than those watching television or using a smartphone, TV connected device, tablet or PC", the audience researchers say.

Radio Kamina

- svensk FN-radio i Kongo

Ronny Forslund

Vid genomgång av en del DX-material efter framlidne DX-vännen Claës-Wilhelm Englund hittade jag en intressant tidning, Djungeltegraf, som gavs ut av svenska FN-bataljonen i Kongo. I detta nummer från våren 1962 berättades om att en egen radiostation var under uppförande. Artikeln publiceras i det följande i sin helhet. Två personer ur radiostaben, Ragge Jagero och Leif Högberg, hade vänligheten att berätta mer om projektet.

Ragge var radiotelegrafist vid 1:a Kompaniet, 20:e bataljonen och senare signalmekaniker. Han blev kvar i Kongo fram till tillbakadragandet av de svenska styrkorna 1964. Ragge berättar om stationens programutbud:

- Morgontimmarna sände vi cirka 06-08 och siestatimmarna ungefär 12-15. Basekot och några andra infoprogram sändes live. Vi bandade och redigerade i viss mån program själva, annars fick vi ner program från Sveriges Radio, typ Hylands Hörna m.fl. Ett kul program som hade en titel som var tagen från Radio Nord var "Låten från båten". Då rodde vi runt i en liten plasteka i den stora poolen vid officersmässen och de simmande FN-soldaterna som var där fick önska en låt. Programledaren hade inte flytväst!

Radio Kamina sände på mellanvåg 530 kHz med en effekt av 1 kW och använde en modifierad fartygssändare av typ Standard Radio ST-450. Antennen var av T-typ och hade en höjd av cirka 30 meter. Så småningom tillkom även en kortvågssändare i 49-metersbandet, även den på 1 kW, för att nå detagementen i Katanga/Shaba-provinsen. Lyssnarrapporter inkom både på mellanvåg och kortvåg, bland annat en rapport från Sydamerika. Har möjligen någon ARC-medlem lyckats höra och verifiera stationen?

Eldsjälen bakom Radio Kamina var kapten Bertil Jernberg, stationschef. Kapten Jernberg var ständigt på jakt efter materiel till Radio Kamina och man fick bland annat överta en del av Radio Nord's skivarkiv när stationen tvingades stänga. En stor del av skivarkivet hos Radio Kamina hade Radio Nord-etiketter.

Programchef Leif Högberg berättar: *Som programchef hade jag tjugofyra duktiga medarbetare, tolv hallåmän och tolv studiotekniker. En pärla bland medarbetarna var den mycket duktiga chefsteknikern, Ragge Jagero från Sala. Han gjorde det omöjliga till det möjliga. Drog kablar och vred och skruvade på alla rattar och några till så att allt skulle vara i topptrim.*

När medarbetarstyrkan fylldes på så startade vi sändningarna tidigt på morgonen, ofta vid 06.30-tiden. Sändningstimmarna var oftast upp till 70 timmar i veckan.

Vi hade nyheter flera gånger under dagen, som vi kallade Dagens Eko, lånat från Sveriges Radio. Nyheterna presenterades på flera språk, svenska, kiswahili, engelska och franska. Underlaget hämtades från bl a BBC, Radio Springbok Sydafrika och Sveriges Radio m fl stationer.

Leif berättar vidare: *Många duktiga hallåmän och reportrar som plockades från Svenska bataljonen gjorde att stationen blev alltmer populär. Bland annat för att Radio Kamina hade mycket musikunderhållning från Sveriges radio och inte minst Radio Nord. En av de duktiga reportrarna var Karl-Erik Olsson, tjänstledig från Dagens Eko i Sveriges Radio. Ett proffs som även var bataljonsredaktör. Ett annat populärt program på lördag morgon var Frukostklubben, idén lånad från Sveriges radio. Det fanns många duktiga förmågor på basen som gärna ville vara med, sångare, gitarrister, dragospelare, någon som ville berätta en särskild händelse på basen eller ute i bushen. Svenska Fältruppen var också med i klubben. Många kända röster, Staffan Tellemar, Siv Öst m fl bidrog med trevligt programinslag.*

Radio Kamina blev den första station som sände till svenskar i FN-tjänst. Men man sände även program för andra bataljoner som "Canadian hour" från Royal Canadian Signals och Norska bataljonens timme.

Radio Kamina flyttades sedermera till Luluabourg (nuvarande Kananga) och byggdes där upp på åtta dagar. Den 23 april 1964 stängde stationen med Kapten Jernbergs favoritlåt *Hey Paula* med Paul & Paula. Ni kan läsa mer om Radio Kamina och andra liknande stationer på <http://www.malish.se>

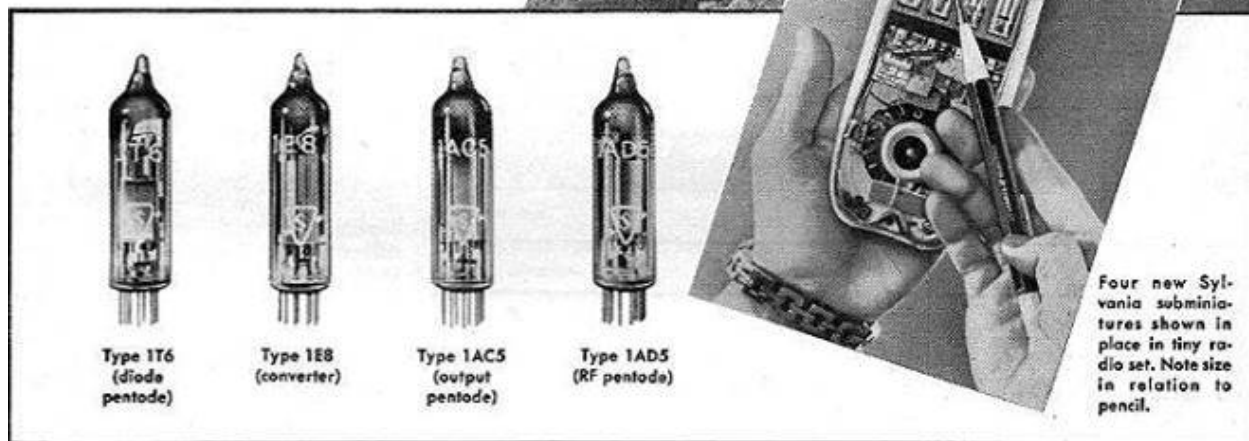
