Yesterday it became known that the founder of the first private radio in the times of the Soviet Union, Radio M1 and the founder and operator of the medium wave 1386 kHz **Radio Baltic Waves**, Rimantas Pleykis died at the age of just 64.

He was also instrumental in the early 2000s that the Sitkunai station got a completely new short wave infrastructure, among other things a direct antenna was built towards the USA. Jaguar – Off topic a little – file recovery

Yesterday I inadvertently deleted some Jaguar recordings that I wanted to keep. I had made no new recordings since.

The recycle bin size can be made as big as you like, but the bigger the bin, the less space there is for new recordings. In my case the files were too big for the bin and were "permanently deleted". I searched to see if there was a way to recover them and I found Microsoft's "Windows File Recovery" available to download (2.34MB) from the [Microsoft App Store](https://www.microsoft.com/en-us/p/windows-file-recovery/9n26s50ln705?activetab=pivot:overviewtab). I'm pleased to say that it works and a whole night's recordings have been restored.

I didn't know this was possible. It might be of use to others in the same situation. You do need to follow the instructions carefully as it uses the command line and therefore requires the syntax to be correct for it to work at all. The recovered files have to be saved to a different drive which can be internal, external or USB but it can't recover to the original drive. 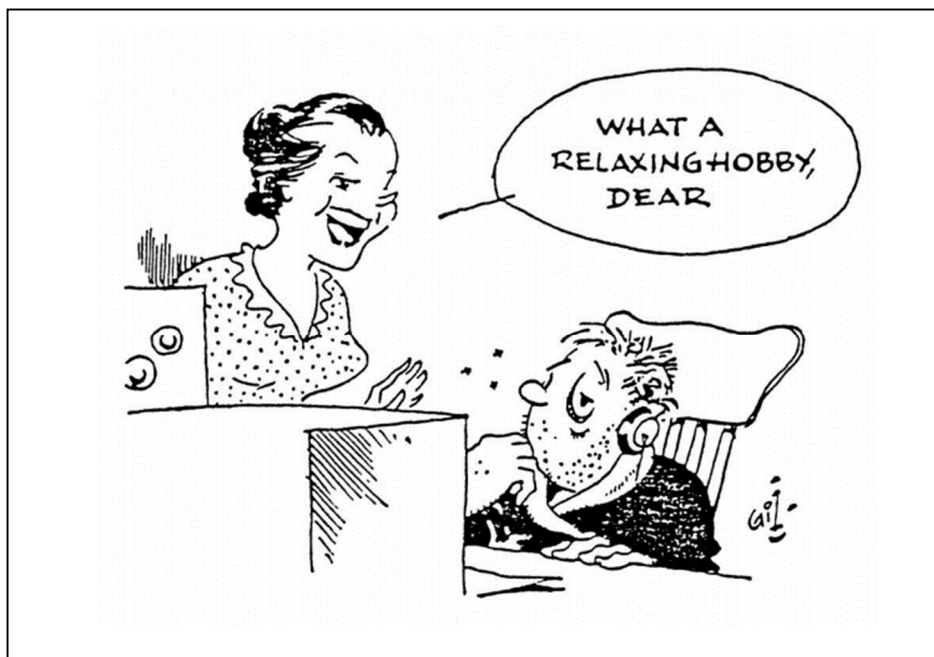
100 years of broadcasting – a nostalgic journey through time

Commercial Radio News

Radio Presenters significantly Reduced22 January, 2021

With half of all local commercial radio stations in the UK now owned by three companies, and national programmes increasingly replacing regional ones, the future of truly local radio is looking uncertain.

In 20 years, local listening has gone from 40% of the market to less than 25%, and many stations have disappeared or been absorbed into consolidated "network centres".

Last year, 36 local commercial breakfast shows were replaced with two national programmes, and 10 entire regional sites closed completely.

"We've seen a lot of local radio presenters lose their jobs and it's quite a sad situation around the country," says Stuart Clarkson, deputy editor of RadioToday.

He estimates that more than 250 presenters will lose their jobs as a result of national programming replacing local broadcasting as the industry continues to shrink. (www.radiotoday.co.uk)

I was looking at the LPAM stations and was aware that **Carillon Radio** has not one but 3 separate transmitters! Details of their history (from their website) is as follows "The station started on 11 April 1976 when as a fledgling hospital radio station we opened as Loughborough Hospital Broadcasting. Our programming in those days was put out live over an internal speaker system to the Loughborough General Hospital, Regent Street and Zachery Merton in Loughborough.

Our service continued pretty much unchanged until 1999 when our station took the bold step of applying to broadcast on medium wave. For a small town based hospital broadcaster the decision to take this route was both daring and innovative. Following a change of name to Carillon Radio in November of that year, the license was granted in 2000 and we became the smallest hospital radio station in the country to be afforded this status.

With ageing broadcast equipment and still based above Loughborough General Hospital's X-Ray department, the race was on to bring ourselves into the 21st Century and commence our new 24-hour broadcasting service on Saturday, 9th December 2000 on 1386 AM from our old but valiant studios.

So to the present, with our committed expansion and growth and with a wealth of experience behind us, we have been granted an even greater honour – to be the first hospital broadcaster in the country to become a Community radio station".

The station broadcasts on 1386 kHz and 1431 kHz to Loughborough Hospital and Coalville Hospital respectively and also at Coalville on 1476 kHz with separate programming with a power of 0.25 kW. (They also relay Radio Seagull some evenings).

WFME is now broadcasting messages of a weaker signal as the power has been reduced to 30 kW. Station will go off on *February 12th* and there are many speculations as to whether 1560 will be back from another NYC area site. If you haven't verified this famous site now is the time to send a report!

In reply to WFME signing off posted by Doug Douglas

Before you go starting rumors and spreading untruths, you should probably ask around for facts. I maintain the WFME site for Family Radio. They sold the land. There are things in the works behind the scenes that I cannot talk about. That being said, the timing of the closing on the land is such that they will be taking WFME silent for a while as other things in the works are taking time. They extended the January sign off to February - at an unGodly sum of money - more than many AM stations sell for these days. It does not make economic sense to maintain the WFME signal at this time. The transmitters and equipment are going to be moved into storage for the time being. The towers are being dismantled and scrapped - the new owner of the land has no use for 4 radio towers and they are, in fact, in their way for their intended use of the land. There is no plan to turn in the license or to sell the license to anyone. WFME will be returning to air, most likely in two stages - reduced power to maintain the license and allow the Commission to act on a Construction Permit - and then build out the CP and sign it back on at full power. Stay tuned. Regarding the damage to the antenna system - a drilling contractor, testing for soil compaction, accidentally took out the control wiring to two of the three towers involved in the directional antenna (they were told not to drill in that area and were on site without my knowledge). By the time we could have repaired it, we would have been close to the January sign off date, so it was chosen to simply stay on night pattern for the time being.

Norske AM-sendere:

Småsenderne II: 1115 kHz LLW Arendal Mellombølgesender NRK Sørlandssendinga Svenn Martinsen

Arendal Kringkaster, eller "Arendalssenderen" ble bygget i 1951 og regulære sendinger startet 8. desember samme år. Den var lokalisert til Vindholmen, som ligger ved Krøgeneskilen like før avkjørselen til Tromøya. Stasjonen sendte på 1115 kHz med 250 watt med kallesignalet LLW og ble stengt 1. november 1978. Senderen var produsert av Tech Laboratories, Jersey City, NJ, og var en av "Larsens Mellombølgesendere"¹ som er nærmere beskrevet i artikkel III i denne serien om LLT Geilo Mellombølgesender på 1466 kHz som vi i Foreningen Bergen Kringkaster har hos oss på Bergen Kringkaster. Andre anlegg som fikk tildelt sendere av dette merket var Langerak, Røros, Sandnessjøen, Sulitjelma, og Longyearbyen(2) kringkastingssstasjoner.

Stasjonen sendte NRK Riksprogrammet, og hadde Sørlandssendinga som Distriktsprogram, men siden Arendal hadde lokalkontor med studio, kan den ha sendt egen lokal sport på søndagskvelder? På denne tiden hadde nemlig mange av NRK regionalstasjoner slike sendinger på søndager 2150-2000 lokal tid. Kanskje hadde man også egen 17. mai morgensending slik som på LLE Bergen Lokal, som sendte på samme frekvens som Arendal inntil 1966? Uansett gikk NRKs distriktsprogram som disse ble kalt 1200-1220 og 1645-1740 mandag-lørdag. Lokale nyheter og værmelding. Utenom Bergen delte LLW frekvens bl.a. med LKE Lista (samme program) og LKN Notodden (Østlandssendinga), og det var vinterstid ikke uvanlig også å høre andre stasjoner som "snakket i munnen" på hverandre når man lyttet litt unna en lokalsender.

Vi har vel ikke mange sikre fjernlogginger av LLW Arendal Kringkaster eller "Arendalssenderen". Stasjonen sendte jo også samme program som Lista så det var ikke lett å skille dem fra hverandre. Men etter nedleggelsen av Lista (1976?) forteller "Mellombølgehørisonger" at Arendal i allefall ble mottatt med distriktsprogram av norske dxere i Oslo og Bærum i 1976 og 1977.

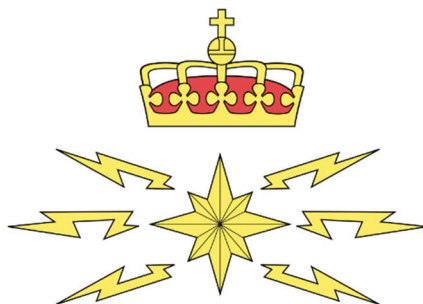
Høsten 1978 jobbet jeg som stasjonsprest ved LTS/Luftforsvarets Tekniske Skolesenter på Kjevik og hørte stasjonen daglig, med et middels signal, både hjemme på Ve, og i leiren. Nedleggelsen 1. november 1978 skjedde i forbindelse med den nye Genéveplanen som ble implementert 23. november 1978, og mye kan tyde på at slukkingen skjedde samtidig med LKK Kristiansand Kringkaster på Flekkerøya på 890 kHz som ble stengt kl. 1004 med Lodin Aukland/Arvid Aanensen/Olav Runde bak mikrofonen. Opptak finnes. Aanensen signerte for øvrig QSL-kort for mottak av Arendal MB sender 17. august samme høst til meg.

Et innlegg fra Magnar Svenningsen på Facebook høsten 2020 forteller om en liten lokaliseringssending i Vindholmenområdet på et gitt tidspunkt:

"Denne senderen ble teknisk driftet av ingeniører fra Televerket i Arendal og hadde kontroll en gang i måneden. Når de begynte med industri på Vindholmen ble senderen flyttet over i lia på den andre siden av veien... var selv en av de som hadde kontroll på senderen..."

En annen korrespondent som var DXLC-medlem, Ragnar Tellefsen, og i mange år radio/TV ekspeditør i Arendal forteller om markert oppgang i salget av FM-radioer høsten 1978!

Hvor tok senderen fra Arendal veien? Kildene forteller at to "Larsen-sendere" er tatt vare på, men kanskje er det tre med den som står på Askøy!

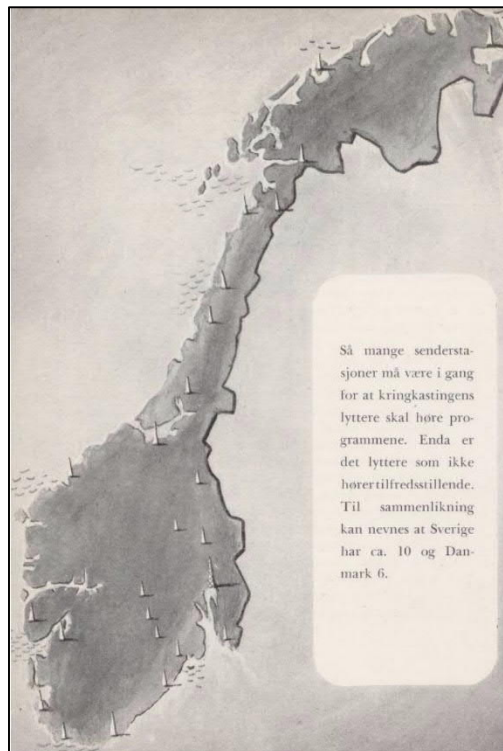

Is There Any Good Year for DAB?

Christer Hederström (*) says that DAB supporters have “exaggerated” DAB success

In “DAB Advocates Celebrated Growth in 2020” and “Assembly Highlights Advances for WorldDAB”

WorldDAB President Patrick Hannon claimed that 2020 was a good year for DAB+. I am disputing that.

Slanted or exaggerated information about DAB have circulated over the years. Unfortunately, such information has indiscriminately been accepted by publishers in Europe and the U.S. The journalistic mission should be to uncover fake news within the media industry.

Many might not realize that WorldDAB is an organization with the purpose to promote the “Digital Audio Broadcast” brand introduced 25 years ago in the United Kingdom, Norway and Sweden. Such a resourceful lobbying body will, of course, never tell us the full story complete with all the inconvenient facts regarding DAB. So, beyond the information barrage by DAB stakeholders, there are a lot of claims to question and investigate.

WorldDAB made some successful lobbying for an EU Communication Code requirement that car radio receivers in new passenger cars - not buses and trucks - must be able to receive “terrestrial digital radio.

“But it is NOT a requirement “to receive DAB+.” This would be contrary to EU competition rules as there are also other system brands for terrestrial digital radio, e.g. the DRM system (established in India), HD Radio (used in the United States), Chinese CDR and the emerging global technology 5G Broadcast. In fact, the European Union has not recommended or defined DAB or any other system as standard for terrestrial digital radio. And probably never will.

Where are the DAB listeners, really? Introducing DAB in a country does not mean that listeners will abandon FM and broadband. Except for the U.K. WorldDAB has not presented any DAB listening figures. It is estimated that less than 1% of the world’s population today listens to DAB radio. In most countries “digital radio” is not DAB, it is radio on the internet.

After the fiasco in Norway the DAB stakeholders are smart enough to report only “digital listening” which includes both DAB and on-line. Big attempts are made to hide the truth. But the Norwegian radio listener is not happy with the national transition from FM to DAB.

In neighboring Sweden DAB broadcasting still exists, but there are extremely few listeners. Why should they?

Since 1995 82 million DAB/DAB+ receivers have been sold in the world. This should be put into the perspective that there are more than 6 billion FM receivers and now more than 2.5 billion smartphones. The sale of standalone receivers is decreasing while the smartphone/connected car will be the only future radio listening platform to challenge FM radio.

The BBC, a pioneer of the development of DAB in the 1990s, now regards the internet as the most important platform for radio and television of the future. BBC is already successfully testing 5G Broadcast in Scotland.

Attempts to include DAB in smartphones have not been successful. A DAB receiver consumes more energy than a corresponding FM receiver. This is a decisive reason for the lack of a global consumer market for DAB. The prospects that DAB will become a major radio listening platform in the U.K. or elsewhere are slim. So why even go on trying?

There are no signs of DAB ever being accepted in the world's 11 largest nations among them China, India, United States, Brazil, Russia, Mexico and Japan, which together muster half the world's total population.

Today most standalone receivers sold including in-car radio are capable for both FM and DAB. In Sweden a new car is a connected car. In a well-covered mobile broadband country this provides superior diversity and sound quality for radio online also in your car.

FM is still available as a robust emergency alert system (EAS) in most countries (except Norway). Finland has recently passed a national law requiring FM for all new cars.

Some countries will go for other digital systems for terrestrial radio such as DRM and HD Radio with better geographical coverage than DAB. These systems use current frequency bands for FM (VHF II) as well as shortwave and mediumwave (HF). Investing in short-range DAB transmitters will be too expensive outside metropolitan areas. This is already on the agenda in Australia, India, Brazil and Russia.

FM will probably be retained for decades in most of the world's 220 countries and territories. Norway occupies a world-unique position as the only country where FM has been replaced by DAB for its national network (FM is retained for local radio). Switzerland might follow suit 2023. In Australia DAB is established in metropolitan areas, but AM and FM will be retained. Among the countries that have previously tested DAB and/or declined public investment at national level are Canada, Hong Kong, Taiwan, Portugal, Spain, Latvia, Hungary, Finland, Sweden, Ireland and New Zealand.

Some digital technologies are short-lived. Remember the CD, the DAT cassette. And watch out; Switzerland last year closed its terrestrial digital television network.

During the quarter-century that DAB existed, the chances of a market breakthrough were significantly greater in the 1990s than today. Then the internet did not exist as a major media platform and DAB could attract with improvements as more channels than FM. Today, the system cannot offer the radio listener any competitive added value when mobile and fixed broadband are already established everywhere. And with FM retained as a global standard.

DAB tried to kill FM, but from behind came internet and killed DAB. There is a lot to learn from this. I look forward to read in-depth reports also based objective sources.

Medium Wave Offset Atlas - all 10 kHz channels, 24 hours

Nils Schiffhauer, DK8OK, mwoffsets & WOR via Thomas Nilsson, ARC

With the new Elad FDM-S3 and its OCXO/GNSS-stabilized clock, I did a 24h recording of the whole medium wave band on January 19, 2021 in Northern Germany. Free software SDR# V3 enabled me to make up a spectrogram of each channel within a window of 50Hz width, and at a frequency raster of 10kHz. You can easily see:

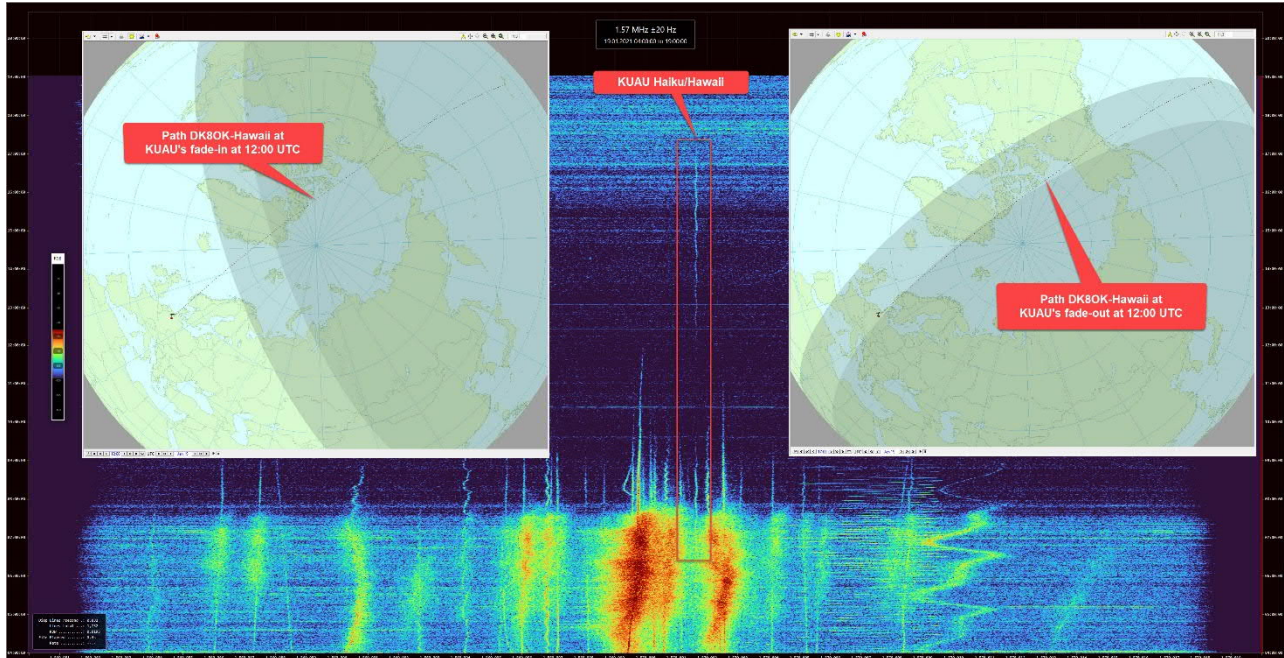
- * sign-on/sign-off
- * fade-in/fade-out
- * accurate and stable frequency offset over full 24h down to a millihertz
- * frequency control of the transmitter's oscillator (stable, drift, sinus, sawtooth ...)
- * propagational effects (doppler, scatter ...)

The format is PDF, DIN-A4, landscape, resolution 300dpi. This allows you to zoom to a factor of about 400% to search for details and better read out of the time/frequency scale. It weighs 559MB. You can download it, and open it with your PDF reader (you can also point your mouse cursor onto the link, click right mouse key, and choose "Save under ..."). Leafing from one page to another gives an interesting overview.

A similar Atlas showing a raster of 9kHz is under way and will be published in due time. It is also planned to publish a general article about the background, about what to do with such a tool, and how to do this by yourself.

I am sure that it will open some new horizons on Medium Wave DXing, including accurate offsets over up to 24h.

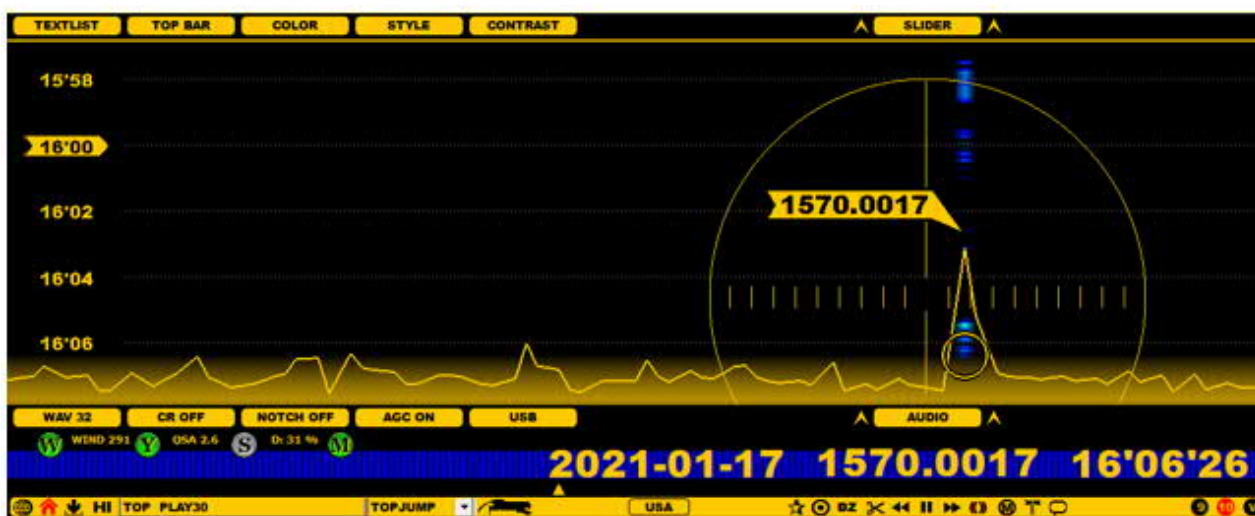
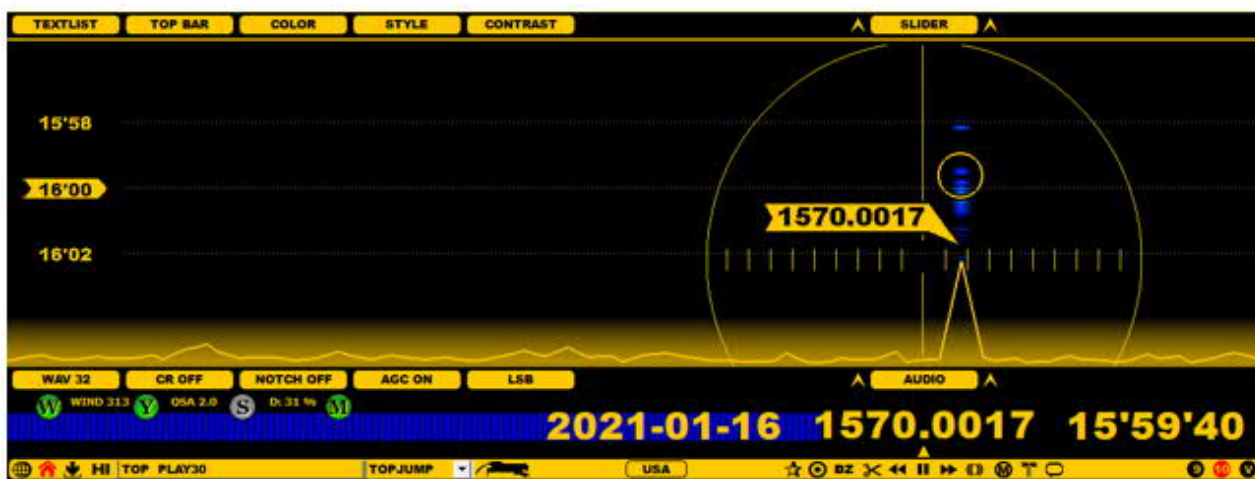
Like his 10kHz brother, it contains the screenshots of spectrograms of each channel over 24 hours, reception in Germany, on January 19, 2021, within a window of 50Hz. Some odd channels had been also included. To nail the actual offsets in but a millihertz-range, I used the new FDM-S3 with OCXO/GNSS control guaranteeing accurate and stable frequencies.

From a recording just two days later, I also added some Frequency Standard and Time Signal stations plus all longwave broadcasting channels (Mongolia!) in just the same manner.

The purpose of this now rather complete "Atlas" is to have an overlook about what can be generally received at my location and with a professional omnidirectional vertical dipole antenna; and to exactly measure offsets. With a system gain of about 70dB, compared to a 10kHz wide channel, stations from Hawaii, Laos, Swaziland etc. had already been identified, e.g. by their times for sign on or sign off plus fade-in and fade-out. Additionally specific offsets further enhance the fun - see Offset List of the indispensable MWLIST.

I now hope to finish a more general article about "How to do", featuring also some brand new software for this purpose. (Nils Schiffhauer, DK8OK via mwoffsets & WOR)

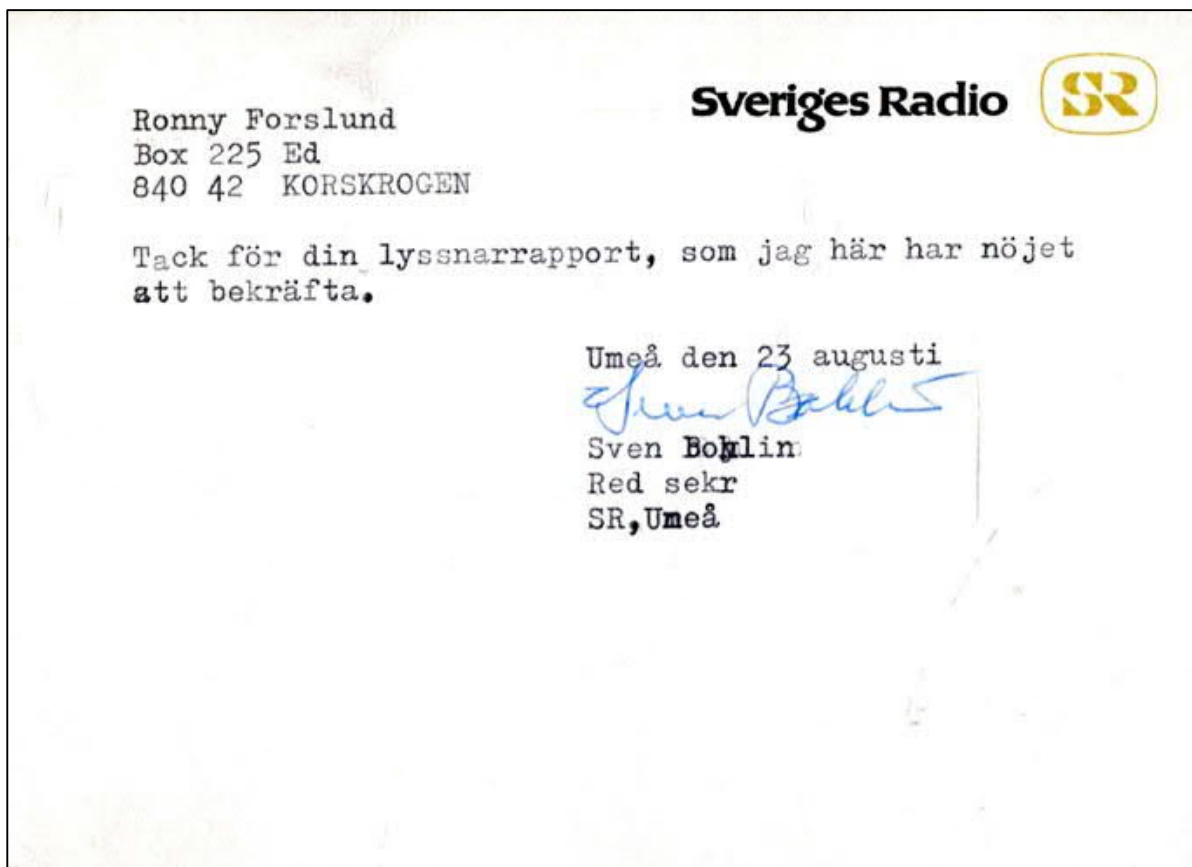

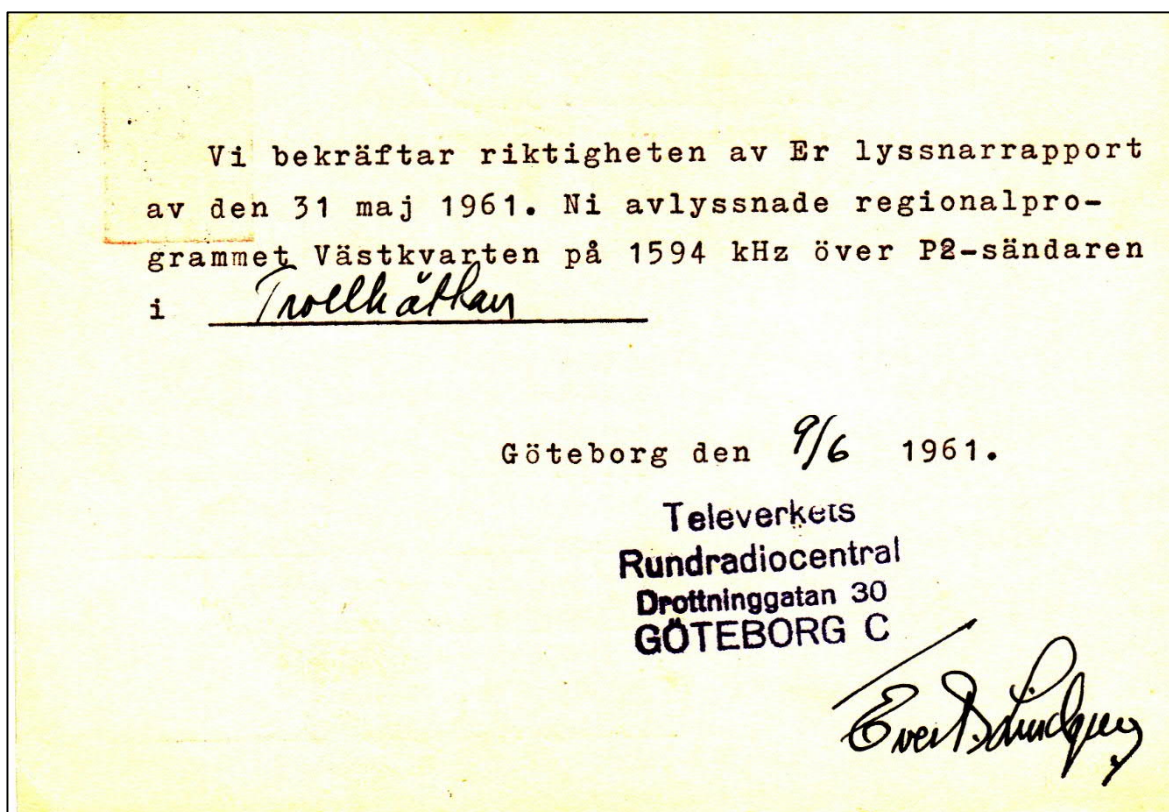

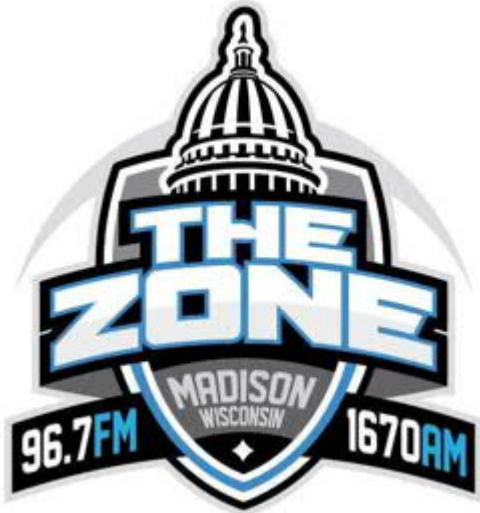
